Welcome and Introduction	As usual, the meeting has started with the recitation of some verses of the Holly Quran by one of the participants, and then the chair has welcomed the participants followed by quick introduction of meeting participants.	
Review of the previous meeting minutes and action points.	The previous meeting minutes has been reviewed and discussed, and most action points has been finalized except two points which agreed to finalize before the next meeting.	
Key Nutrition Services and Situation Highlights, Particularly the new IDPs Influxes (#HH, Screened U5 & PLW and their Categories)	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>CESVI</b></p> <p><b>CESVI</b> shared with Nutrition cluster they started resilience project with two fixed sites in WADAJIR by 15 August 2018, also shared that they are planning to start one mobile team in October once staff recruitment finalized. For new influx of IDPs, CESVI has shared they have seen 351 HH in Wadajir, 14 SAM cases, 35 MAM cases, and 97 PLWs, also they mentioned that they registered 7856 beneficiaries in scope registration since March,2018.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>PAC</b></p> <p><b>PAC</b> updated they have seen 220 HH in Tabelah and Dacas area, and they had screened 48 PLWs, 12 SAM, and 46 U5 MAM cases.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>WARDI</b></p>	<p><b>Action Point 1:</b></p> <p>Hijra to follow-up their requested supplies with UNICEF through FMOH.</p> <p><b>Action Point 2:</b></p> <p>The NC will communicate with UNICEF to accelerate SORRDO PD, and to be allowed supplies earlier to cover the OTP gap in Warta Nabadda.</p>

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**WARDI** has shared with Nutrition cluster, that they have started two mobile and two fixed sites in Kahda district August 2018, also mentioned that the two mobile teams have not yet started immunization activity while the fixed sites are fully operating. They also shared that WARDI Hamar jajab site PD is not active.

### ACF

**ACF** has shared with the cluster they received 56 cartons of F100 from ICRC as they were facing shortage of this supply, also they shared with the cluster they have seen 336 HH during their assessment in tabeelaha area, and most of the new arrivals has settled in Allafuuto camp, also they mentioned that they conducted three trainings, IMAM training for 21 staff, IYCF training for 29 staff and 12 TBAs has also trained.

### MERCY USA

**MERCY USA** shared with cluster they started resilience project in Yaqshid district with 4 fixed sites and two mobile teams, also they mentioned the PD of kahda site is not active, and they added they had screened 85 HH of new IDPs in ceelmoge and socdaal area, so they reported 18 SAM cases, 55 MAM, and 20 PLWs.

### HIJRA

**HIJRA** is running two OTP centers (one fixed and one mobile) in Kahda area and they had admitted 220 SAM children in September and 193 SAM cases in August 2018, also they distributed hygiene kits to 400HH from IDPs in kaxda district. They also reported that they are facing supply shortage and submitted their request to the UNICEF

### Action Point 3:

NC will confirm the status of AID VISION's Nutrition Center as UNICEF confirmed that their PD has ended last month.

### Action Point 4:

JAMHURIYA HC Will share with the NC their Screening figures for the last Quarter.

### Action Point 5;

NC will follow-up the PCA status of BH's SC with UNICEF to avoid any further suspension of the service or breakage in supplies.



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## UNICEF

**UNICEF** has briefly updated the Cluster on resilience project and the area of operating this project, especially Bandir region with below table;

UNICEF Also shared that all KFW partner has received supplies except SORRDA which the PD not yet signed, also they added that the Scope registration will be only based fixed sites, and all partner has trained in Dollow Somalia except two IPs (CISP and SORRDO) which planned to train in Mogadishu, finally UNICEF encouraged partners to submit supply request timely to avoid such shortage of supplies and service gap.

## SORDO

**SORDO** updated the Cluster that they are continuing MCHN and TSFP activities in Warta-nabadda, but OTP part are still gap for the whole district for the last four months, also they shared the PD with UNICEF not yet signed.



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## SAFE-UK

**SAFE-UK** shared with the Cluster that they will start two fixed sites in Kahda area, they have also shared that Qoryoley camp has been evicted.

## SCI

**Save the children** has shared with the cluster they are continue implementing TSFP and MCHN project in Hamarweyne, Waaberi and Deynile, and admitted the following beneficiaries to the program for last quarter; 3030 U5 children MAM cases and 635 PLWs with MAM has admitted to TSFP, while 25517 U2 children, 9431 PLWs and 2083 delivered mothers has benefited the MCHN component for last quarter.

## SOYDA

**SOYDA** shared with the cluster that they have seen, 107 HH at the area of Omar Fiyaasko in Kahda District, and 111 HH in Deynile District.

## JAMHURIYA HEALTH CENTER:

A representative from community based health center called **JAMHURIYA HC** shared with the cluster that there is gap of Health and nutrition in Jamhuriya village of Karan District and only one health center is operating in entire the district which could not cover the needs of whole district, the representative furthermore added that volunteers from community are conducting screening and health education messages with minor health services to the community through the support of the FMOH.
