Weekly

46% of HHs reported price increases

27% of HHs reported shortages

Shop Closures

4% of HHs report their local shop is closed

HH Expenditure & Purchasing Habits

IQD 149,000 Total Expenditure (in past 7 days)

IQD 83,000 Of Total, On Basic Needs

46% HHs decreased purchasing goods

45% HHs purchased the same amount of goods

15% HHs increased purchasing goods

Work

88% of HHs have been unable to work in the past 7 days

Reasons:

Because of curfew/movement restrictions related to COVID-19

Because of changes in business activity related to COVID-19

Because of other reasons
