Background of the reported incident:

A letter has been submitted by ZBL ANDMA On 19 Feb 2017, the letter indicated that a heavy rainfall and flood has caused the destruction of several houses and property in Qalat city of Zabul province which has caused several damages and affected some of the population, UNOCHA Kandahar office invited an emergency Ad hoc coordination meeting, the meeting participants decided to conduct joint assessment team for further verification/finding of real needs.

IOM take the leading of joint assessment team for rapid assessment of reported areas.

Key findings from assessment:

The assessment team has carried out assessment in different site of reported location of Qalat city of Zabul province. the assessment team precisely verified eligible families based on criteria and needs. the assessment has been completed within two days. Below is the detailed assessment result.

Qalat city of Zabul province:

The joint assessment team has been formed and the rapid assessment carried out. The team has found total 25 families/ 190 individuals eligible families whose houses were severely and completely destroyed due to flood/heavy rainfall.

Outcomes of the assessment:

Detailed RAFS are attached to the report:

Water and Sanitation:

The affected families are using bore-well, open-well and hand pump for washing and drinking water, they have access to enough drinking and washing water.



Shelter:

Verified families are living in their own damaged houses, open space, tents and with host families the flood has severely and completely destroyed their houses, mainly rooms and walls of their houses. The joint assessment strongly recommended household items including tent and shelter.

Food:

Considering the assessment findings, the team has recommended food items as their houses are severely and completely destroyed and food items have been destructed the families are vulnerable and faced with lack food items.

NFI:

As per joint assessment finding the houses were severely and completely destroyed and their household items including beds and cloths were washed due to flood. The families are in dire need of NFIs, thus the assessment team has recommended NFIs to affected families.

Education:

The families have access to school and no major damages of school facilities/infrastructures reported.

Health:

The health centers are close to the residential areas and team has found no serious concerns in health sector.

Conclusion:

In the view of assessment findings all the assessed families' houses are severely and completely destroyed and their household and food items were washed by flood. The team has identified total 25 families in Qalat city of Qalat province. Considering the existing vulnerabilities of the affected families the assessment team has recommended NFIs and Food items for total eligible families. The provision of recommended assistance will reduce the existing vulnerabilities of the affected families, their basic emergency needs will be addressed and the families will be protected from the ripple affected of harsh weather conditions.
