2. Context

Description of shock: on 3 Sep-2019 AOGs attached on Qurghan Tapa and Abfrosh ha villages of Imam Sahib district in Kunduz province, due to this conflict between AOGs and ANSF some number of families have been displaced from their places of origin to Imam Sahib district center and other secure villages, The assessment teams which were formed of staff from ACTED, CTG/WFP, ADA, WAW and local DoRR to identify the needs, based on Joint assessment teams finding, These families are currently living primarily with relatives and in rental houses with many unmet humanitarian needs, we divided the caseload into two phases to have an on time response, therefore the first phase already planned to be responded under Caseload C084 in current week and this is the second phase of Imam Sahib caseload which will be covered under C092.

3. Needs and recommendations

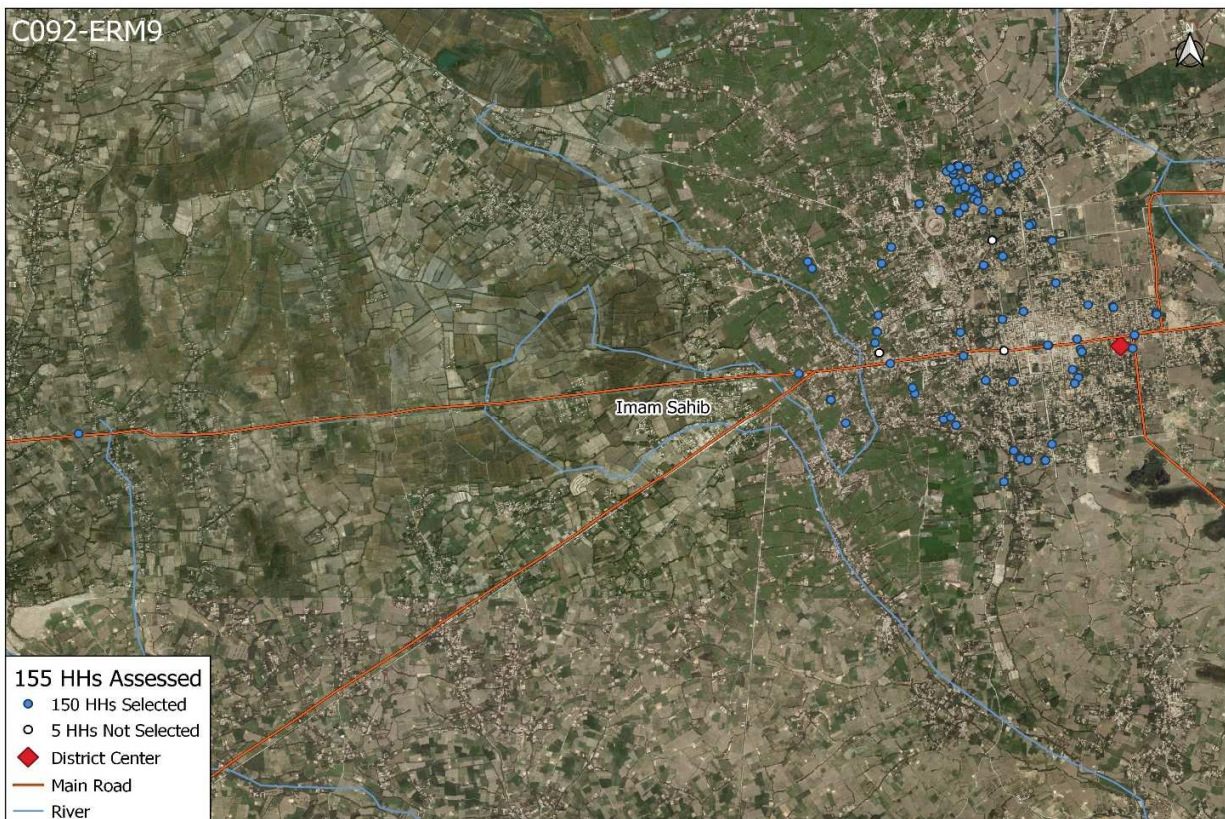
IDENTIFIED NEEDS

Food	124 Households with very low food consumption score (no food stock). Three Households with food stock less than a week. 28 Households with food stocks between 1 to 3 weeks.
NFIs	All 150 HHs in need of NFIs (blankets, buckets, tarpaulins and Kkitchen kit)
Financial status	154 Households experienced a drop in income as result of shock,4 Households is in debts less than 2,000, 24 Households are in debts between 2000 and 8000 and 126 HHs are in debts more than 8000 and just one household no debt since the shock.

Shelter	154 Households reported that are living in the houses and one household reported that they are living in Makeshift shelter. (69 HHs in rental, 69 HHs are Hosted / sharing with friends or relatives, 17 households reported living with free of charge).
WASH	All the households have access to safe and clean water for drinking, cooking and bathing. 4 IDP families are still doing open defecation due to unavailability latrine facility in their households and wash partners has plan to do wash re-assessment. The remaining IDP families have been using family pit latrine (used by 140 IDPs families) and Community latrine (Used by 11 IDPs families).
Protection	The team reported about two persons who injured in last conflict in Imam sahib district and they need to cash to cure their wound.

PLANNED RESPONSE

Food	ACTED will distribute, 12,000 Cash to cover two months food for 150-HH. $150 \times 12000 = 1,800,000, \text{AFN}$
NFIs	ACTED will distribute 6,000 Cash to meet the NFI need for all 150-HHs $150 \times 6000 = 900,000, \text{AFN}$
