

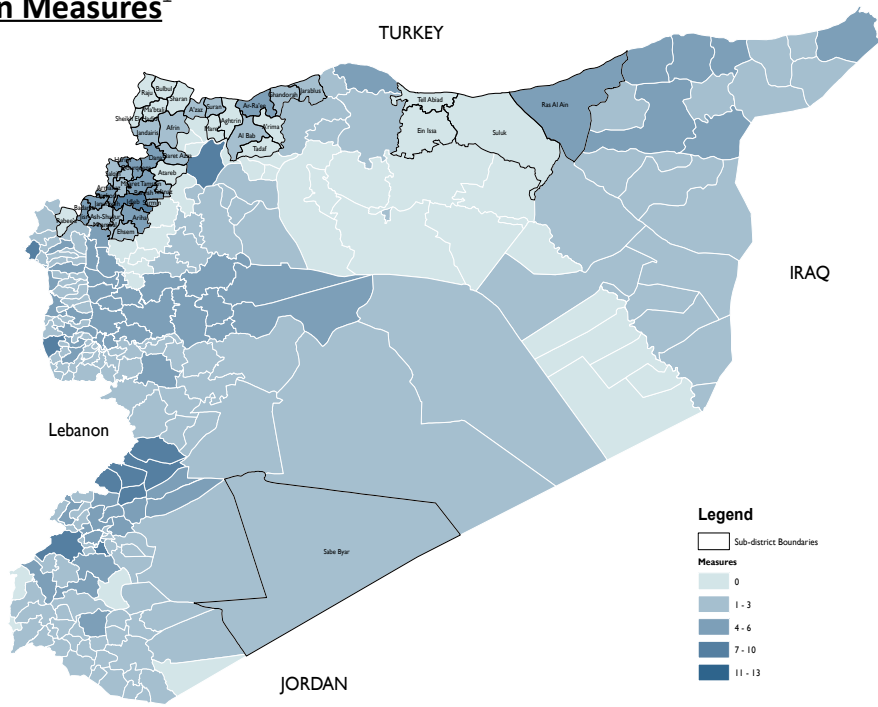


Non-State & Turkish-Backed Armed Forces Controlled Areas

This report provides an overview of the response to COVID-19 in NSAG & TBAF controlled areas. Data collection was undertaken at the sub-district level on Saturday the fourth and Sunday the fifth of July, via 137 face-to-face key informant interviews in 43 sub-districts.

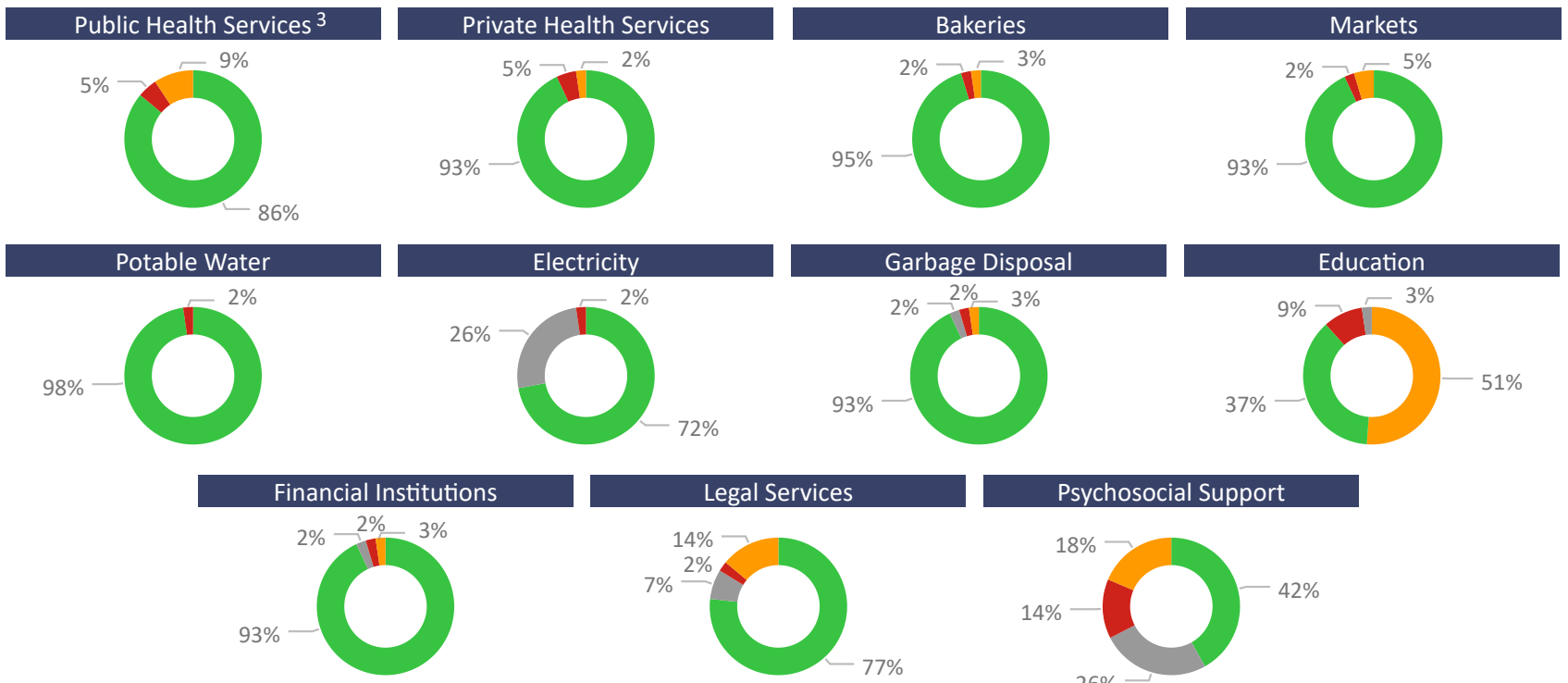
