Assessment of Rain Fall affected families in Kunar province

Date of Incident: 19-Feb-17

Date of Assessment: 22 to 27 Feb 2017

Date of Distribution: 27-Feb-17

Subject: Assessment of Rain Fall affected families in (Asadabad, Marawara, Nurgal, Dara-i-Peach, Watapur, Shigal, Asmar, Dangam, Nari) districts of Kunar province.

Incident Summary:

Initial information was obtained from Kunar ANDMA and indicated that 76 families have been affected in above mention districts of Kunar province by heavy rain fall incident, Kunar ANDMA called OCT meeting and presented the figures of affected families on district level, as well decided to reach the relief item very quickly on time to the affected families, the floor established 3 teams for quick action, TEAM 01: IOM was assign to cover Asadabad, Marawara, Nurgal districts. Team 2: IMC, ANDMA was assign to cover Watapur, Dara Peach. Team 3: ARCs was assign to cover Shigal, Asmar, Nari, Dangam district to find the accurate figures & need of the affected families, WFP was assign with all teams to cover the food need of affected families.

Assessment Team Observation:

According to the joint team (IOM, WFP, IMC, ANDMA) observation & physically assessment, they found 47 families eligible for HAP criteria in the

above mentioned districts, who have lost their NFIs, food, Shelters as decided in OCT meeting IOM will provide NFI to Asadabad, Marawara, Nurgal districts affected families, IMC will provide NFI to Watapur, Dara-i-Peach districts affected families & ARCs will provide NFI to Shigal, Asmar, Nari, Dangam districts affected families, ANDMA will refer the caseload to WFP for food, further detail of assistance in the below paragraphs.

Team 01 IOM: According to the assessment outcomes IOM found 01-family in Nurgal, 2-families in Asadabad, 2-families in Marawara districts, total these 05 families recommended for 5-BM, 5-FM, 5-WCM & 5 food packages

Team 02 IMC: According to the assessment outcomes IMC found 04-families in Watapur, 16 Families in Dara Peach Districts, total these 16 families recommended for 16-household item kit & 16 food packages

Team 03 ARCs: According to the assessment outcomes ARCs found 10-families in Shegal, 3-families in Asmar, 6-families in Dangam, 3-families in Nari districts, total these 22 families recommended for 22-household item kits & 22 food packages, 04-Family Tents only for 4 completely destroyed families, it is worth to be mentioned there is 14 animals were killed.

Note: the recommended food packages should be provided by WFP

Water and Sanitation:

Based on the assessment team observation they have clean water source for drinking & washing and no one complained for their water sources.

Shelter:

According to the team observation 4 families completely lost their shelters & remain shelters were severely damaged & their shelters need to be repaired, but the severely damaged families have alternative place/rooms for current living & for completely destroyed families tents provided by ARCs.

Food: These families are getting food from market, and also they have some income from their agriculture lands and after the disaster they lost their food stock inside the house therefore team recommended them for food assistance.

NFI and Household Items:

According to the physical check they have not sufficient materials to solve their problems in household's items after disaster; it is therefore the team recommended for nonfood items

Health and Hygienic:

Residents of the mentioned districts have access nearest BHC clinic and as well there are available district level DHC clinic too.

Education:

Schools are available in the village they have primary and High School on District level for male and females, no any school damaged due to the incident, all girls and boys go to school as usual.

Distribution of IOM NFIs and Outcomes:

- **IOM distribution:**
IOM distributed 05 Family module kits, 05 Blanket module kits, 05 Winter Clothing Module Kits, in Asadabad, Nurgal, Marawar, districts of Kunar Province on 27-Feb-17.

Assistance by Other Organizations/Agencies:

- **IMC distribution:**

IMC distributed 20 household module kits in Watapur, Dara Peach districts of Kunar.

- **ARCs distribution:**

ARCs distributed 22 household item kits & 04 Family Tents in Shigal, Asmar, Nari, Dangam districts of Kunar.
