Narrative Report of Rain Fall affected families in Kunar province

Date of Incident: 22 July 2017

Subject: Assessment of Rain Fall affected families in (Khas Kunar, Narang, Chawkay) of Kunar province.

Incident Summary:

Due to the current rain fall in Kunar province, ANDMA received some petitions about few families affected in Chawkay, Khas Kunar, Nurgal districts, as it was individual families & very small caseload, ANDMA assigned IMC/WFP colleagues to cover the need of Narang & Khas Kunar districts affected families, as well ANDMA/ARCs/RRD will cover the need of Chawkai district.

Assessment Team Observation:

According to the joint team (IMC, WFP, ANDMA, ARCs & RRD) observation & physically assessment, they found some families eligible for HAP criteria, 4 families in Chawkay, 4 families in Khas Kunar & 2 families in Narang districts, due to the need of affected families joint team decided, IMC will provide NFI to Khas Kunar & Narang districts, ANDMA/ARCS/RRD will provide NFI to Chawkai district as well WFP will provide food to all district affected families, as well the shelters reconstruction remain as gap

Water and Sanitation:

Based on the assessment team observation they have clean water source for drinking, washing and do not complaining for the clean water.

Shelter:

According to the team observation three families severely damaged their shelters and were not able to use as living room, but they have alternative place/rooms for their living.

Food: These families are getting food from market, and also they have some income from their agriculture lands and after the disaster they lost their food stock inside the house therefore team recommended them for food assistance.

NFI and Household Items:

According to physical check they have not sufficient materials to solve their problems in household's items after disaster; it is therefore the team recommended for nonfood items

Health and Hygienic:

Residents of the mentioned districts have access nearest BHC clinic and as well there are available district level DHC clinic too.

Education:

Schools are available in the village they have primary and High School on District level for male and females, no any school damaged due to the incident, all girls and boys go to school as usual.

IMC distributed 02 household item kits, in Narang & 04 more NFI kits in Khas Kunar districts of Kunar province.
- **WFP distribution:**
1: WFP distributed 06-food packages to 06 families affected by rain fall in Narang & Khas Kunar districts of Kunar province
- **ANDMA/RRD/ARCs distribution:**
In Chawkey district 4-NFI kits distributed by ARCs, 4 Hygiene kits by RRD & 4 food packages by ANDMA.
