

## Pachieragam and Chaparhar IDPs Crisis in Nangahrar

### Joint Assessment report by Afghanaid

Date of Assessment: June 21 and 22, 2017

Assessment members: Afghan Aid, DoRR, WFP-PAT (DoRR allowed the team to conduct the assessment without the member participating so it was Afghanaid and WFP-PAT who conducted the joint assessment.

Response alert was raised by June 19, when a special approval for this response was obtained. Initially Afghanaid NFI assistance was supposed to target families affected from natural disaster, due to the severity of the case ARC leadership decided to participate in this response.

Coordination: On June 20 morning an introductory coordination meeting was conducted with esteemed UNOCHA colleagues (Sayed Alam Khan and Ismail Amn) as result of which Adha Akhondzada and Lalma villages were given to Afghanaid for conducting the need assessment and the response. It is also mentionable that other areas were given to different organizations prior to this meeting and Afghanaid was filling an important gap which was not covered by any organization. The members of join monitoring were also identified and the contact details were shared. A briefing from SCI colleagues were also received on the modalities of assessment in the field, because they were engaged in the assessment from the start.

During the 2 days of the assessment, the joint team visited 83 families and selected 40 of them for NFI assistance. Petition of 31 families were provided by DoRR and the rest of the families were assessed. During our assessment in Akhundazada, we collected information about security of Lalma area which actually is a part of Chaparhar district not Behsud and our findings showed that it was not safe enough for a day or two long assessment, so Afghanaid did not conduct any assessment there.
