## Key achievements since 19 Feb 2016

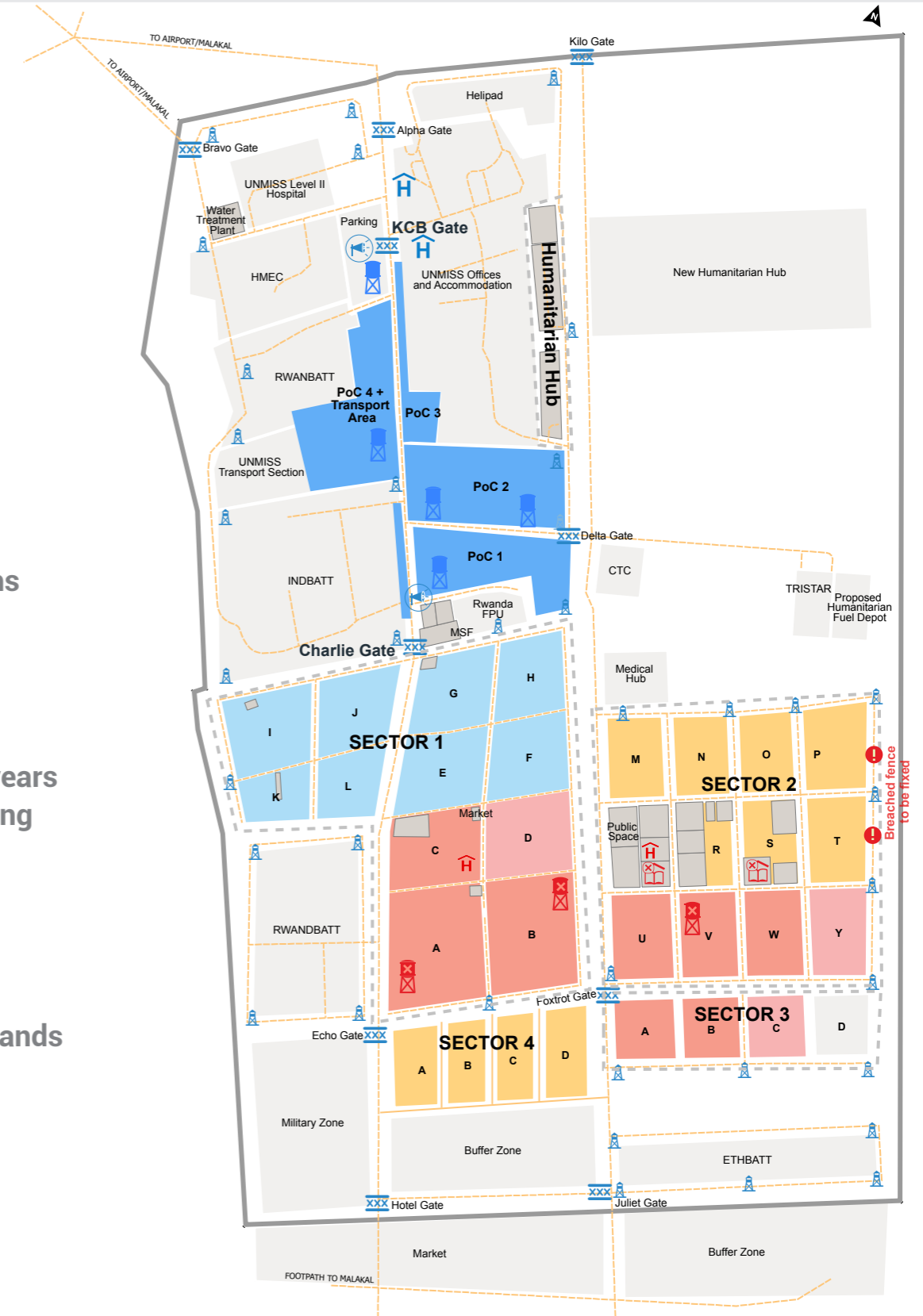
**544,430 kg food distributed to 40,115 people**

- 46% of the remaining shelters in sector 2 were assessed under poor condition and needs replacement
- Conducted service monitoring in sector 1, 2, 3 and 4

- With support from the shelter team, a total of 49 shelters constructed for high risk Person's with Specific Needs (PWSN) in Sector 1 block A1, B2 and part of A2.
  - 84 additional shelters will be constructed for PSN's in blocks A1 and 2 and B1 and 2.
  - In partnership with UNHCR, DRC protection team identified, verified additional 48 PWSNs in sector 1 block A and provided additional NFI kits.
  - Continuously conducting the regular protection monitoring

- 21,135 children attended CFS in the POC and Malakal town this week
- Children reunified with mother this week
- 10 recreation kits, 10 EDC kits, 8 CFS kits and 1 mega phone delivered this week for the use in Child Friendly Space in Wau Shilluk
- 29 UAC, SC, and MC registered this week
