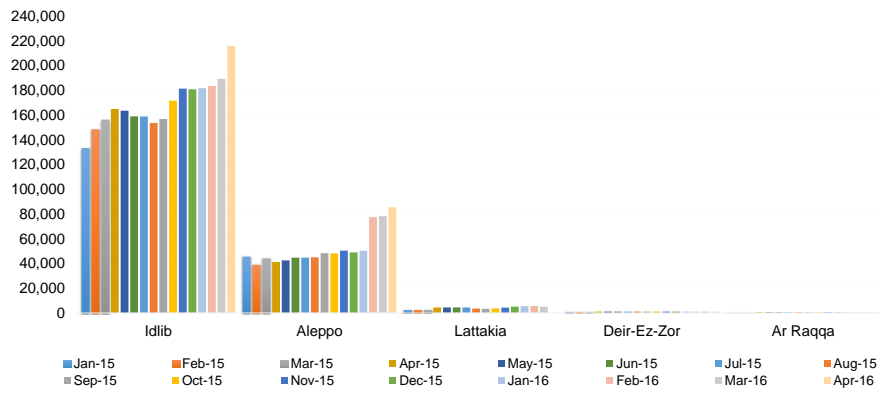

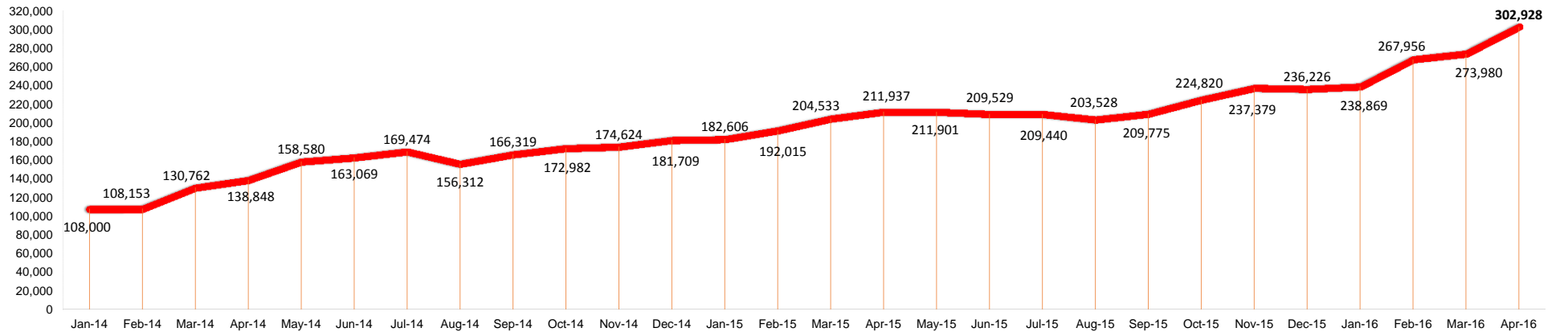
Type of Location
IS Informal Settlement Also called *spontaneous settlements* or *self-established camps*. They are a group of tented or other types of housing units established by the IDPs themselves or by non experienced actors, constructed on land that the occupants have no legal claim to.
PC Planned Camp The structures that are established by an accountable humanitarian actor and to the extent possible, they meet the minimum SPHERE standards.
CC Collective Center Other types of settlements, i.e. public buildings, schools, private collective building, i.e. factories that are inhabited by the IDPs.
TC Transit Camp The camps that were established for a short period of time and no longer exist. This definition does not correspond to the internationally agreed standards per se, the CCCM give definition to these camps that existed for a short time and then disappeared as the IDP moved out.

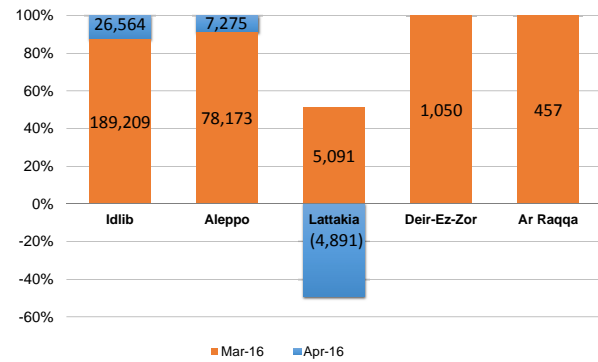
IDP trends in settlements by Gov. since January 2015



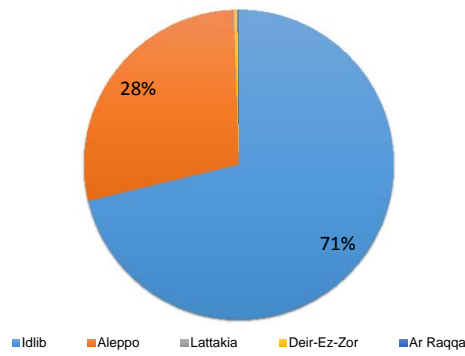
IDP trends since January 2014



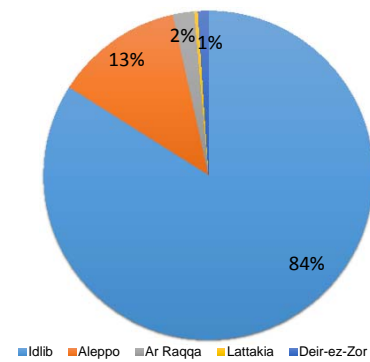
Change in the # of IDPs by Gov. in April 2016
