2. New Business

- Updating NCPWG rolling workplan

To align with the existing CPWG initiatives, CWC and UNICEF will review and consolidate the workplan to include COVID priorities. The updated workplan will be shared in the next meeting.

- Workshop on RA10821 Localization

This spinoff activity was identified from the [NCPWG New Normal Guidelines in COVID context](#). The objective is to come up with AIP menu templates that the LGUs can use to localize RA10821, with reference to the [Child Protection Minimum Standards](#). The idea is to develop a CPIE preparedness and response menu that LGUs can select from, depending on their context, and available budget.

The CPWG members were divided into breakout groups to review the following CPMS standards and select activities to be included in the AIP template:

- a. Establishment of Child-friendly Spaces: CPMS Standard 15 &17, Philippine CFS Guideline
- b. Case management for unaccompanied and separated children: CPMS Standard 13 and 18
- c. Training of Emergency Responders on Child Protection: CPMS Standard 2 and RA10821 IRR
- d. Information management: CPMS Standard 5

For LGU budget reference, the CPWG also suggested costing per PAPs in the AIP Template.
