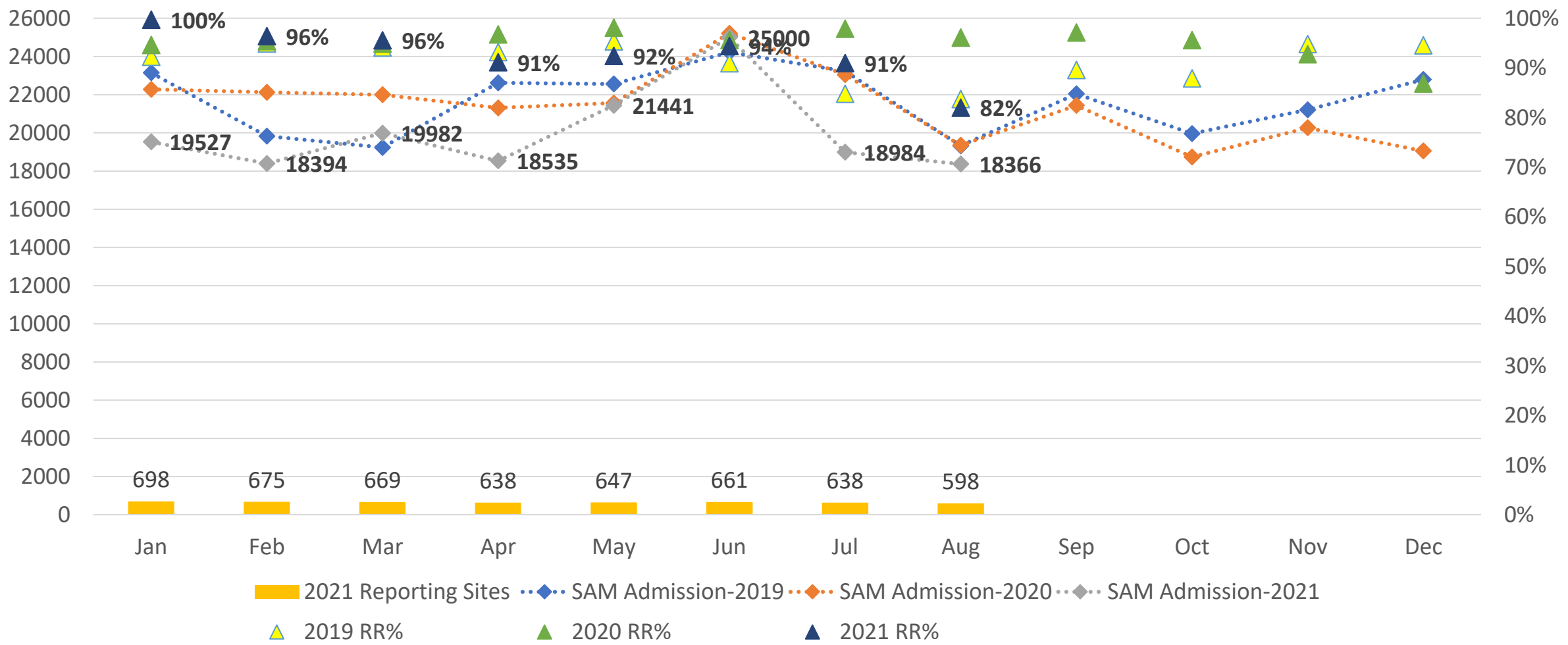

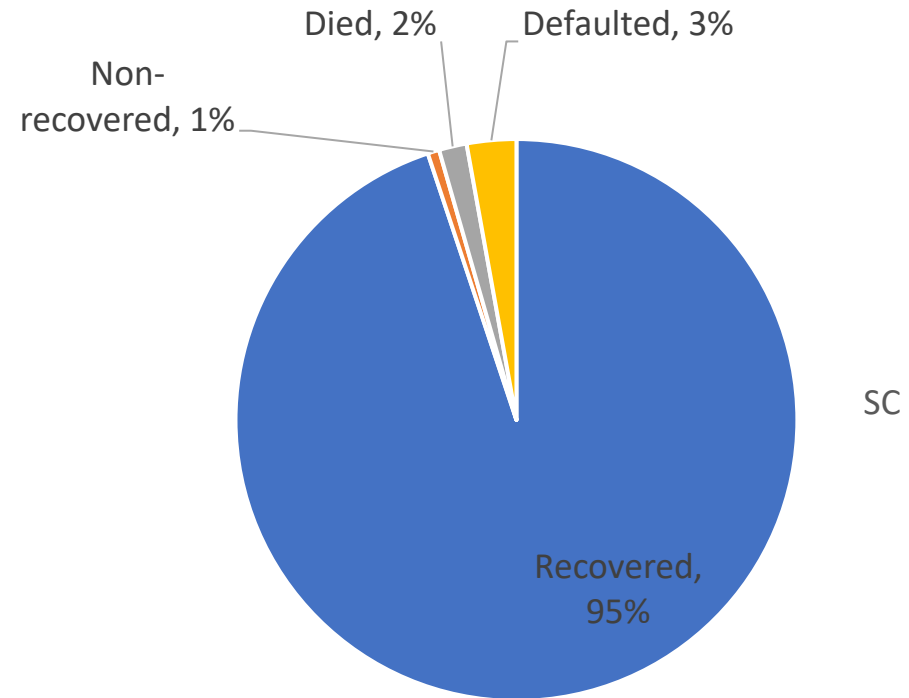
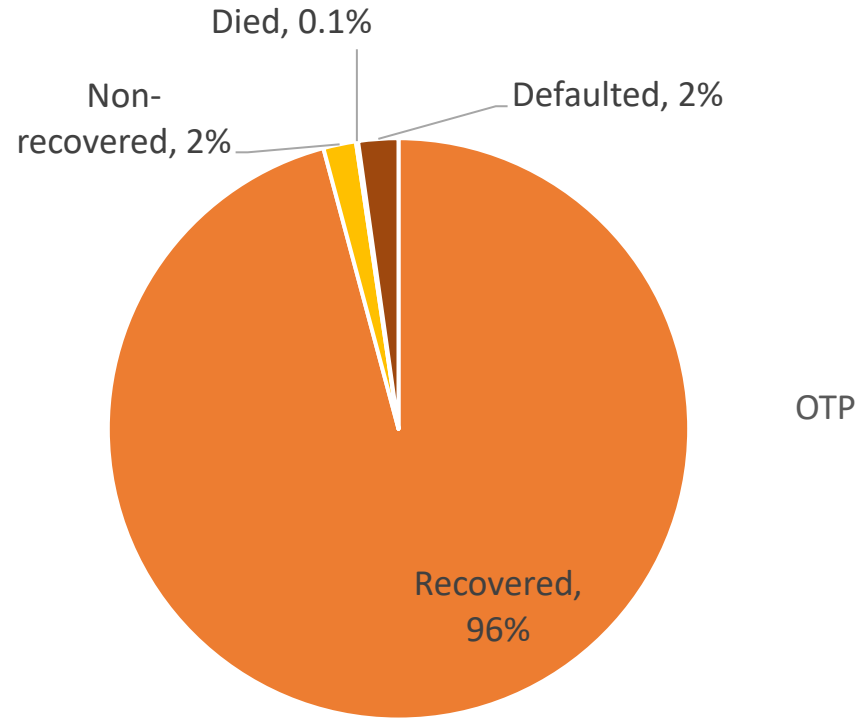
SAM Admission Trend 2019-2021

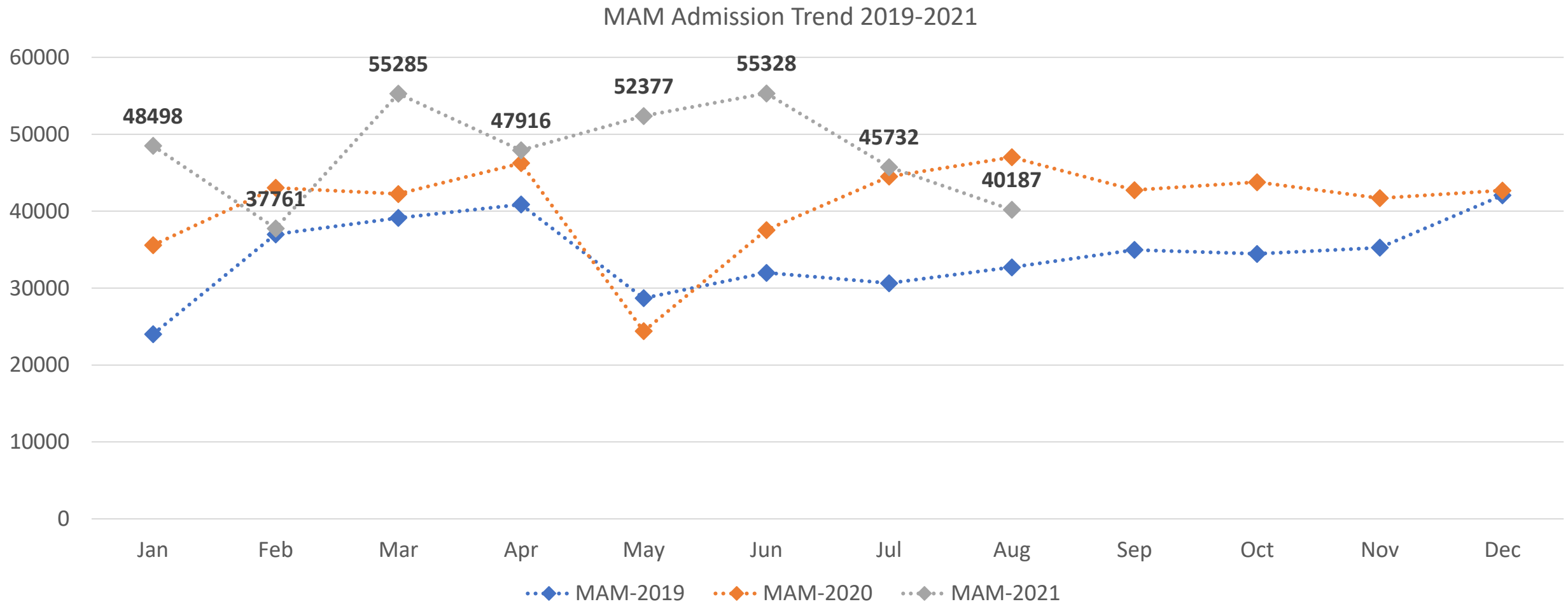

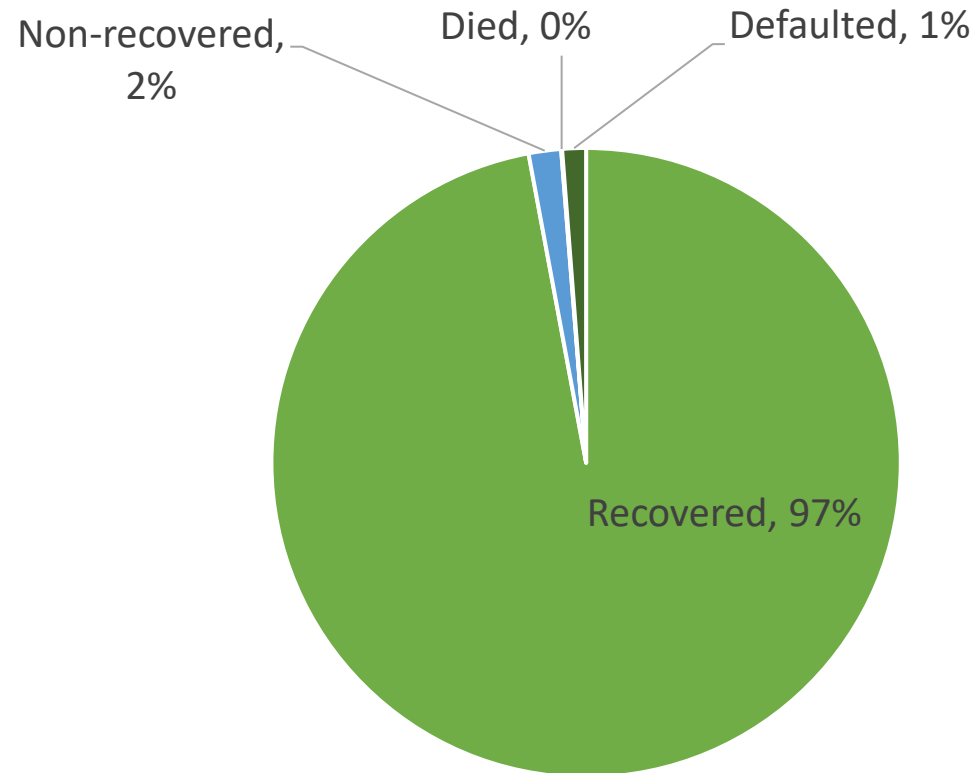

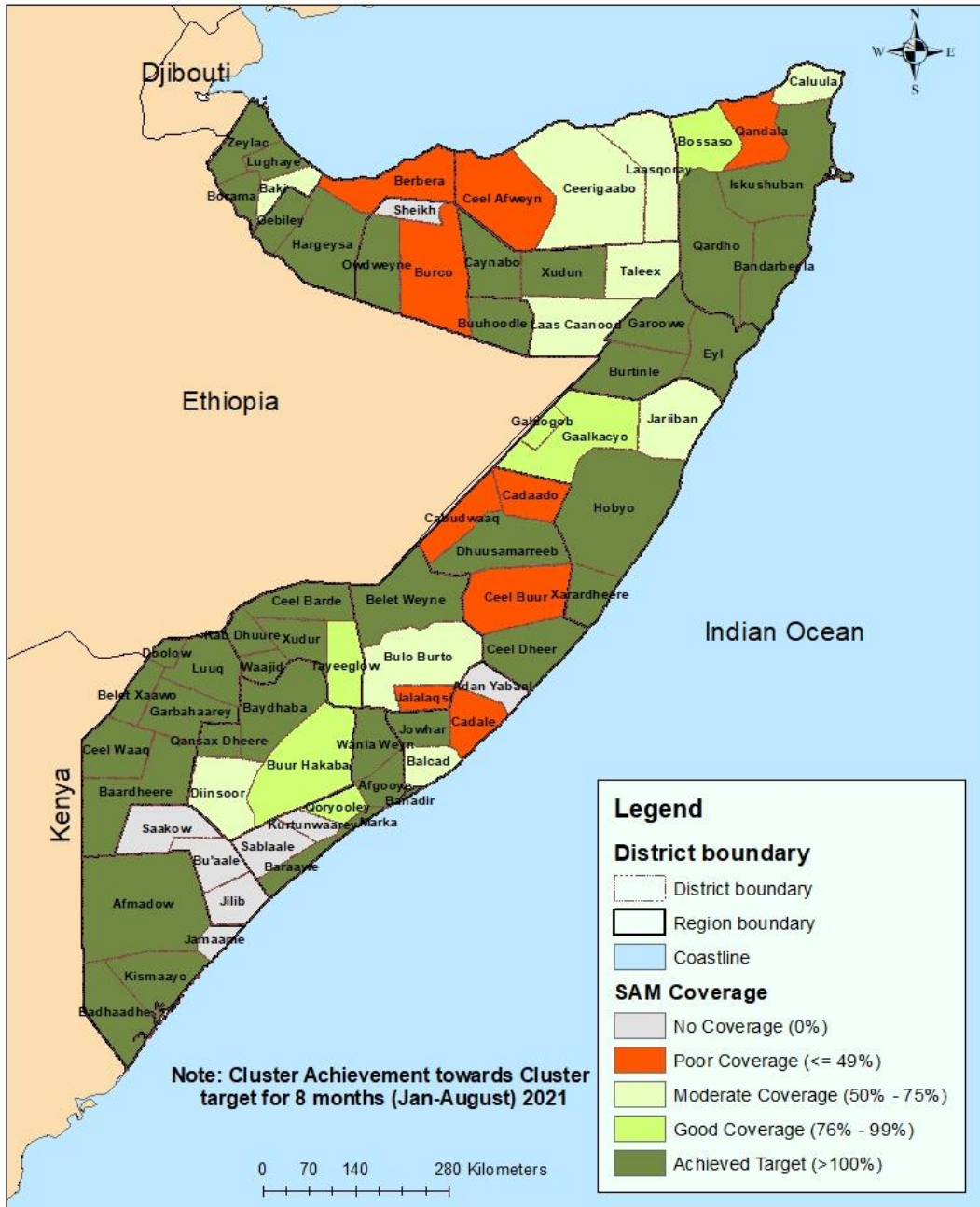

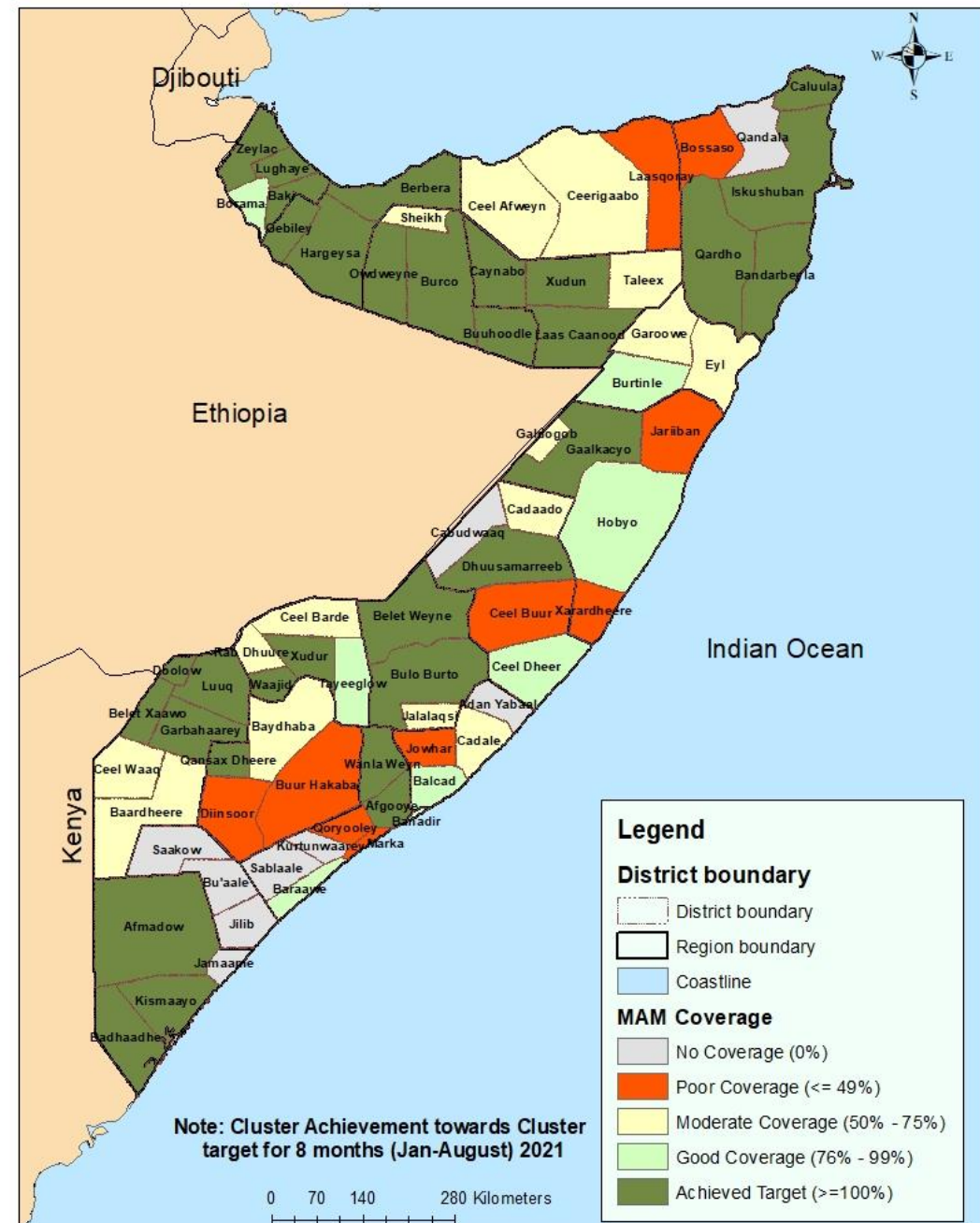
