Incident	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • On 17 July 2018, the National Hospital of Nawa was reportedly damaged as a result of the latest military campaign in the last 72 hours. The level of damage could not be estimated due to the difficulty of communication. • The hospital was separately operated by both GoS-DoH and NSAG. • No casualties were reported form DoH staff. • The director of hospital (NSAG) was reportedly killed, while no confirmed casualties reported form NSAG staff.
Prior Health Facility condition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The hospital’s part operated by GoS-DoH was partially functioning providing health services for 1,237 patients during June 2018. • The total health staff of hospital’s part operated by GoS-DoH (nurses, midwives ... etc.) is 106, while no doctors available.
Impact	The hospital is still partially damaged and has become non-functioning
