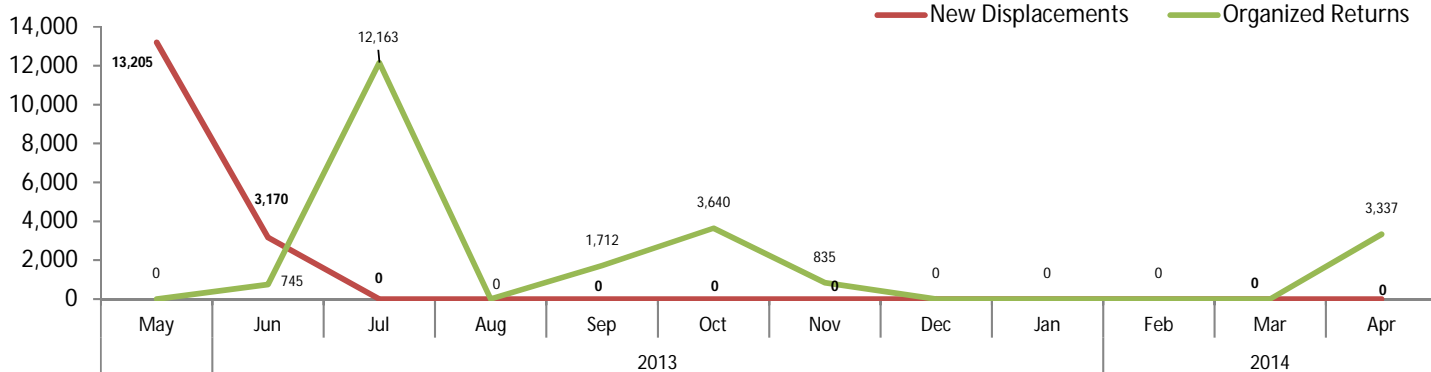

- IDP Camp population reduced as a result of the recently conducted baselines officially endorsed by CCCM cluster. All IDPs who were not found in Camp are reclassified as Off-camp IDPs
  - 1,874 families from South Waziristan were added back to the IDP population following the agreement of UN agencies and Protection Cluster with FDMA that their areas are still affected. These were previously marked as spontaneous returnees
  - In addition to the return of 3,337 NADRA verified families, 403 families not verified by NADRA also returned to safe areas in Central Kurram. The total number of families returned is 3,740
