

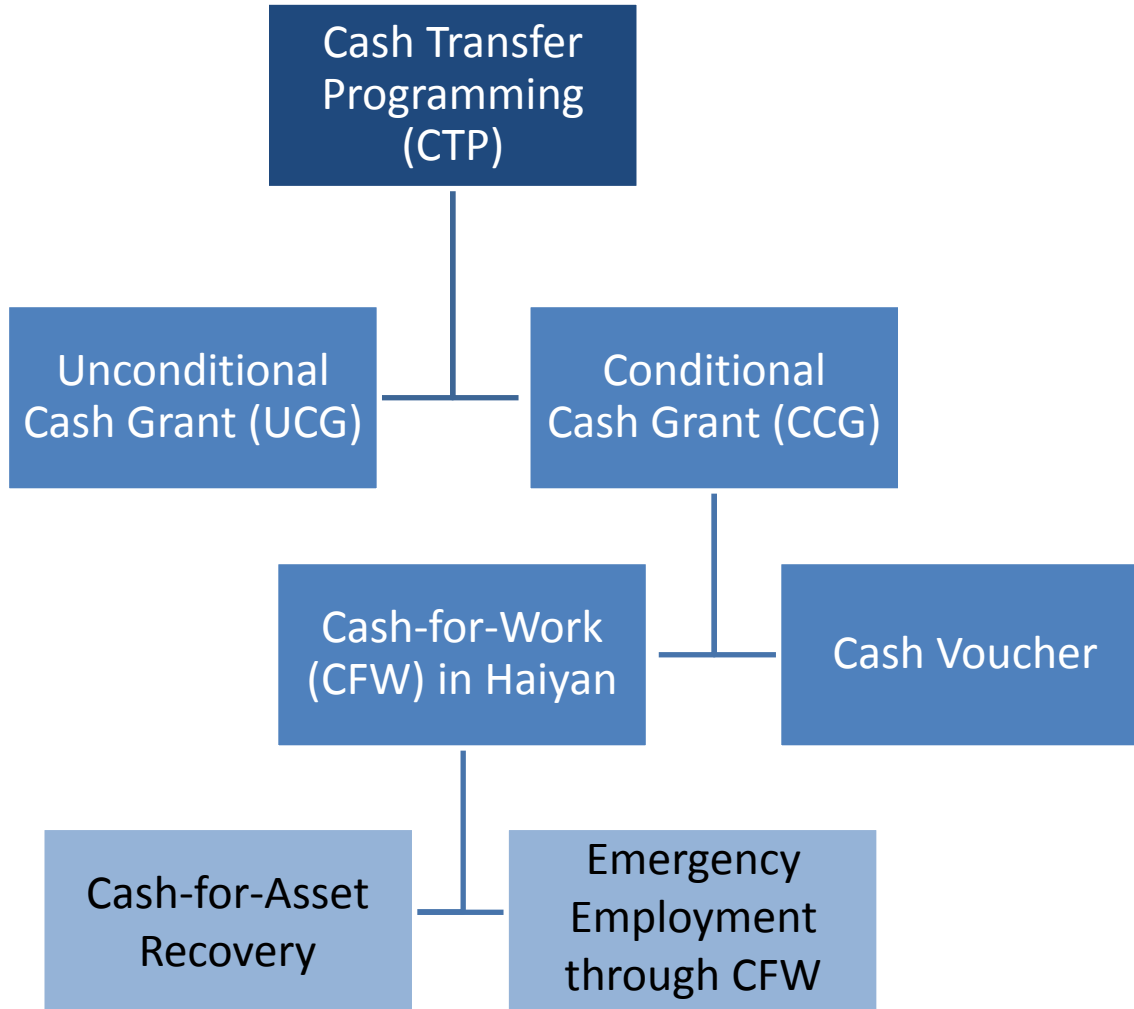
Defining 'Cash-for-Work' in Typhoon Haiyan

Aims

- (1) Distinguish the different activities that fall under the banner of **'Cash-for-Work'** in this response
- (2) List the main objectives and activities linked to public infrastructure works (**'Emergency Employment through Cash-for-Work'**) and support for personal and small-scale community asset recovery (**'Cash-for-Asset Recovery'**)
- (3) Identify the **main clusters** through which the activity should be discussed and reported because, in many cases, the cash is purely a modality that serves a broader objective (e.g. food security)



Cash Objective	Cash Activity and examples	Cluster
Overall: to address immediate household-level food security and non-food essential needs, and to restore existing personal and small-scale community assets	Cash-for-Asset Recovery	FSAC Shelter
Recover personal or community assets that have a direct benefit to the household	Debris clearance Preparation of farmland Replanting on private land De-silting of irrigation canals Restoration of personal property (i.e. boat repair)	FSAC
Restore shelter	Repair (roofings, adding new CGIs, putting up temporary walls) Upgrade (timber work, replacing elements, expansion, adding latrine) New Build	Shelter

Cash Objective	Cash Activity and examples	Cluster
Overall: to recover public infrastructure and spaces, and create immediate income and social protection for working men and women	Emergency Employment through Cash-for-Work	ER-Livelihood Education FSAC
Create physical access to homes, communities, and critical public facilities and services (schools, clinics, barangay halls)	Debris clearance and reconstruction of public service infrastructure	ER-Livelihood Education
Skills/on-the-job training that will assist vulnerable people moving into employment	Income support for skills training and support to MSMEs and entrepreneurs	ER-Livelihood
Environmental rehabilitation and improvement works	‘Greenworks’ – i.e. large-scale reforestry, mangrove rehabilitation, riverbanks stabilisation	FSAC ER-Livelihood
