

### Background

This snapshot shows the projected status of key humanitarian supply pipelines at the national level for a set of relief items that are regularly stockpiled in Afghanistan. Not all stockpiled items are included. The projected requirements are based on current caseloads, as well as projected figures for how many people may be affected by natural disasters and/or conflict based on historical data and early warning forecasts. The capacity of humanitarian agencies to import relief items is dependent on funding, import requirements and the stability of local and international suppliers.

### Key messages

- Supplies of emergency shelter kits, health kits, medicines, water and sanitation kits, and nutrition supplements are all at risk of imminent pipeline breaks at or before the end of September unless additional funds are made available.
- Several other items, including emergency NFI kits, hygiene kits, and supplementary feeding supplies for children risk a pipeline break depending on additional needs, problems with international suppliers and available funds.

## Food Security and Agriculture

**Main challenge:** There is a 2,720 MT deficit in food stocks and US\$ 2.7 million funding gap. Access issues in NSAG-controlled areas continue to pose challenges.

## Emergency Shelter & NFI

**Main challenge:** Main challenge: Lack of funding. There is a \$26.7 million funding deficit. Depending on the rate of new displacements and returns, as well as political unpredictability, NFI kits may run out by late September 2019.

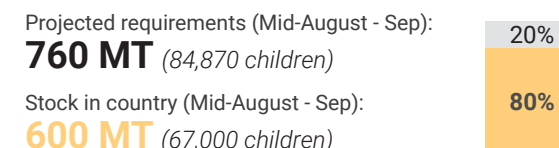

**Main challenge:** Lack of funding. There is a \$9.8 million funding deficit and the sector is also experiencing problems with international suppliers. Requirements and available stocks listed below are until the end of September. If there is no immediate order processed for RUTF, there will be no supply available from 1 October.

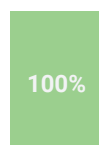

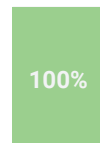

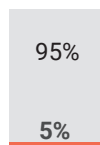
### Health

**Main challenge:** Lack of funding. There is a \$3.1 million funding deficit. The health cluster will divert resources to avert full break. There is also a gap in stocks of loose medicine due to funding constraints.

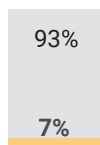

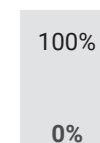

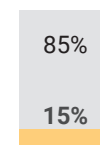

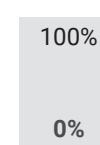

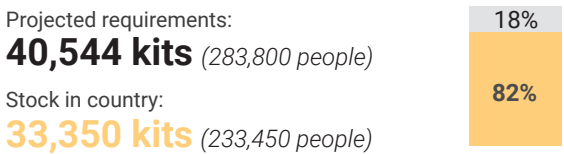
### Water Sanitation & Hygiene
