Conflict displacement in Kandahr, Uruzgan and Hilmand; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • OCHA informed that due to recent conflicts in Uruzgan, Hilmand and Maywand, Shahwalikot, Nesh, Khakrez districts of Kandahar has produced large number of conflicts IDPs. DoRR office in Kandahar, through letter has informed about displacement of 404 IDP HHs from aforementioned locations to Kandahar city, Zheri and Panjwai districts and are in dire need of humanitarian assistance. Similarly, DoRR office in Uruzgan has also informed about displacement of families from Nesh district to Tirinkot and as well as pending NFIs and hygiene response to 1176 HHs in Tirinkot. • Regarding conflict IDPs in Kandahar city, Zheri and Panjwai districts, it was decided that the inter agency committee will sit to screen received petitions of 409 HHs reported displaced from Hilmand, Uruzgan and contested districts of Kandahar. In case of need of joint assessment, NRC will lead the joint assessment team and transportation will be provided by NRC, DRC and SCI and the assessment date will be informed by OCHA when confirmed. • Regarding conflict IDPs displaced from Nesh to Tirinkot, the agencies shared their concerns about government interference in the assessment. The meeting decided to conduct a screen committee after the distribution for 607 HHs is completed. The date of screen committee will be informed by WFP.
