

## Kunduz OCT & IDP Coordination Meeting

### **1. Welcome and introduction:**

OCHA welcomed the participants and thanked participants for timely participation in the OCT meeting.

### **2. Humanitarian Situation Updates by (all participants & OCHA):**

The main focus of the meeting was access to Khanabad district IDPs which recently more than 200 families have been displaced due to heavy conflict between two local commanders from Ghorbandi, Bahadar Khan, Bandar Shurab, Mirawhasan and Qalai-Moonshee villages of Khanabad district to center of Khanabad district of Kunduz Province. After long discussion it was agreed that:

- DoRR Office call and invite Khanabad IDPs representatives and district authorities tomorrow on 30 Mar 2017 at 02:00 pm to Kunduz DoRR Office,
- OCHA and other related humanitarian agencies will be gathered in DoRR Office to negotiate with Khanabad IDP representatives and district authorities about access to Khanabad IDPs.

### **3. Access to Khanabad IDPs:**

As agreed all humanitarian actors and more than 15 community members and district authorities have been gathered in DoRR Office. The main focus of discussion was access to Khanabad district IDPs and negotiation with community elders.

After long discussions the IDPs representatives agreed on below action points:

- They selected five representatives and Haji Ziawolhaq head of CDC selected as general representative for above mentioned affected villages of Khanabad district.
- The assigned representatives will collect the most vulnerable displaced families list and share with DoRR Kunduz Office on 02 April 2017.
- The collected list will contain (name, father name, village name, phone number, national ID card number, destructions, casualties figures) of displaced families.
- The list should be confirmed and signed by Haji Ziawolhaq, otherwise it will be not acceptable for the assessment teams.

- If the assessment teams want to visit closely the displaced families, IDPs representatives facilitate the access to Khanabad district center.
- The IDPs representatives promised that by coming of assessment teams they will fully support and provide all facilities for identification of displaced families.
- At the end they shared their contact details which is attached for your information and each assessment team will have a representative of IDPs as guide during the assessment in the field.
- Kunduz Humanitarian Agencies will conduct another meeting for establishment of assessment teams after receiving of IDPs list on 02 April 2017.
