New conflict and drought IDPs and update on joint assessment

- OCHA informed about DoRR and ANDMA Hilmand letters stated that 350 conflict induced IDP HHs reportedly displaced within Garmser district. Meanwhile, 349 more protracted IDPs which the most vulnerable requested DoRR to be assisted with warm clothes for the children. Moreover, ANDMA Hilmand informed about 55 new drought IDPs arrived from several districts of Hilmand to Lashkargah.
- OCHA shared information that UNICEF showed willingness to cover the needs of the children subject to the result of any joint assessment. Therefore, OCHA asked HAPA to conduct assessment which will be participated by DoRR, CoAR and possibly APA. The assessment should be conducted based on the number of children and report will be shared with OCHA and UNICEF to assist in coordination the response on timely manner.
- WFP/PAT informed that they received information about the caseload of 350 conflict induced IDPs reported by Garmser district governor and DoRR. WFP/PAT stated that the IDPs are protracted and should be confirmed with DG before conducting precise assessment. OCHA asked DoRR to confirm the information to OCHA which will assist to take necessary action.
- In relation to 55 drought IDP HHs, OCHA asked IOM to conduct assessment in Lashkargah to assess the needs of the IDPs. OCT agreed that OCHA to send a nomination email which will enable humanitarian partners to nominate field staff who will assist IOM to kick off assessment as soon as possible.
- Action Against Hunger (AAH) updated OCT members about the ongoing assessment in Lashkargah and informed that the first phase of assessment completed and verified 68 IDP HHs. For the IDPs, OCHA coordinated response and the IDPs were assisted with WFP food, DACAAR hygiene kits, UNICEF WASH NFIs and IRC cash. Moreover, the second phase is ongoing and update will be shared regularly.
- In relation to the issue of Malistan and Jaghuri IDPs, assessment team informed that the IDPs don't have enough documents which has hesitated joint assessment teams to verify the IDPs. Therefore, DoRR should review the list of the IDPs and report the actual beneficiaries to the joint assessment team. DoRR and OCT agreed to on the point to review the list which will assist JAT to assess the needs of the actual IDPs in the field.
- DoRR director informed that the department will establish an internal system for the upcoming steady displacement or the IDPs who are bringing petitions to DoRR. The system will analyse the petitions before sending to OCHA or assessment teams and the system will assist JAT to avoid consuming unnecessary time in the field to verify unreal IDPs. OCT agreed to support DoRR in strengthening the system that could help the existed humanitarian partners to reach the actual IDPs for assistance.
