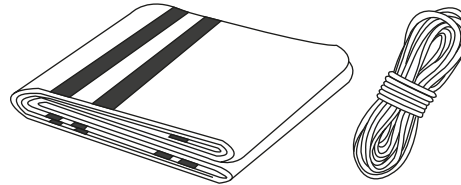

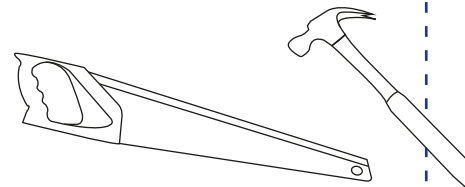
Immediate - Life Saving



EMERGENCY SHELTER KITS

to provide immediate, covered living space within houses that have lost roofing but remain structurally sound. This will provide privacy, protection, as well as speed up the recovery process.

Tool Kits may also be provided to communities to speed up the initial fixes and set ups.

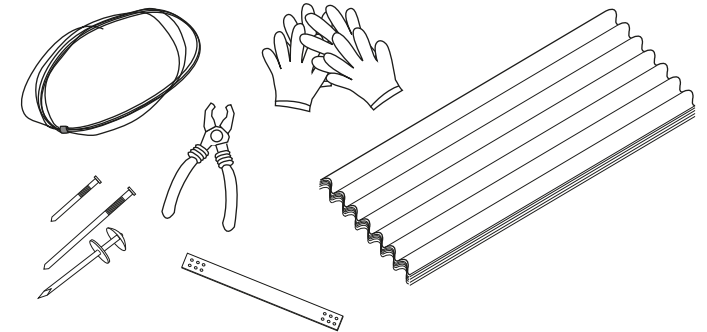


Recovery

ROOFING KIT

for repairs of roofing in houses where the structure remains undamaged by the hurricanes.

Accompanied by technical guidance to ensure adequate assessment, repairs and fixings.



PUBLIC INFORMATION CAMPAIGN

for all stages of the planning and implementation process. A public information campaign via posters, radio and community focal points will explain the shelter options available and provide technical guidance on the use of emergency shelter and shelter repair toolkits.

HOUSE OR LAND DESTROYED

UPGRADE

of selected collective centres or host families

CONSOLIDATE

people unable to return into upgraded collective centres or host families

CREATE

individually tailored longer-term solutions
