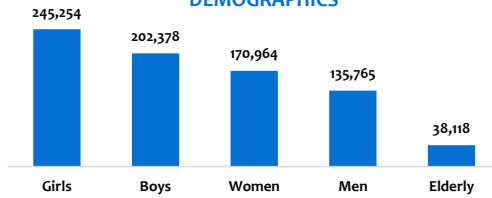

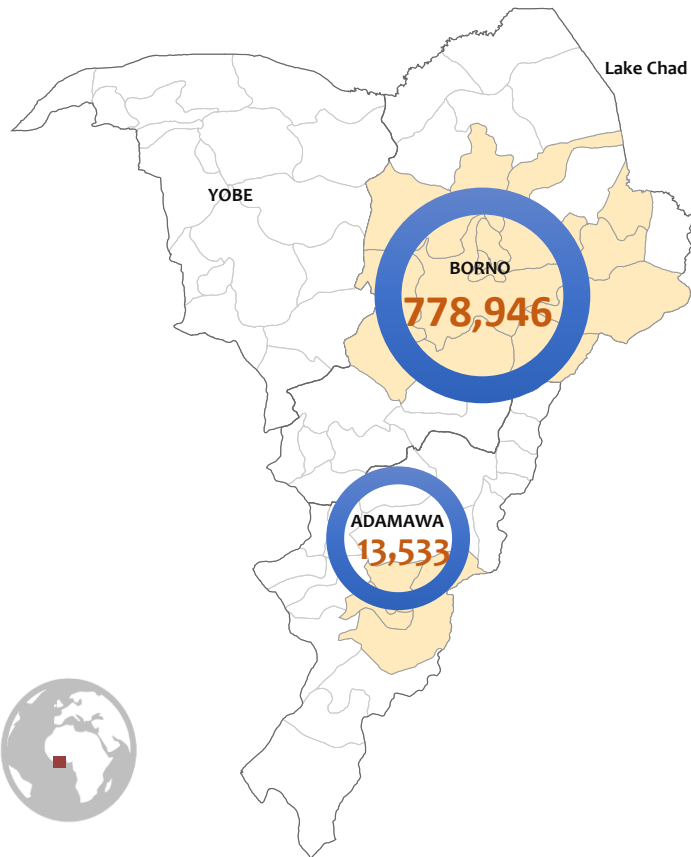

OVERVIEW BY SECTOR OBJECTIVES AND INDICATORS

Objective 1: Continue tracking and monitoring displacement and mobility, with sex and age disaggregated data and information on needs and gaps for a comprehensive follow-up on displaced populations to inform interventions across sectors

- # of eligible individuals biometrically registered
- # of eligible households manually registered
- # of camp/ site profiles (including service monitoring) produced
- # of displacement tracking reports published

Objective 2: Enhanced displacement management to ensure that minimum standards are upheld and pathways reinforced for direct assistance, through capacity-building, community participation, on-site or mobile facilitation and camp management support and case-by-case

- # of displacement sites receiving site facilitation support (mobile and dedicated)
- # of functional reception centers managed and/or improved
- # of camp and camp-like settings decommissioned
- # of # of site managers trained on DMS / CCCM
- # of local and IDP leaders trained on DMS / CCCM

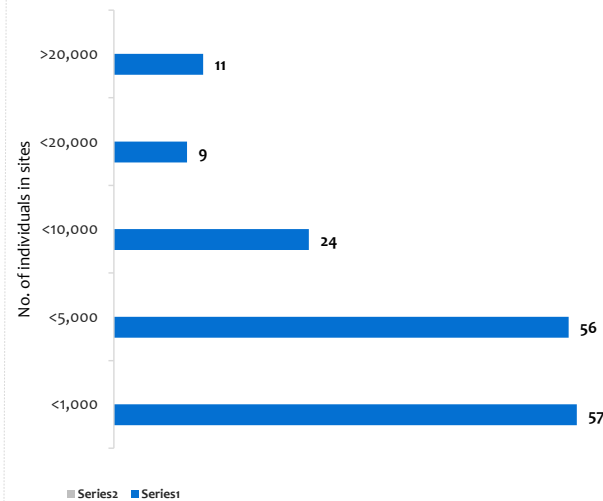
Objective 3: Support maintenance, upgrade, care and decongestion of sites through site planning and improvements when required as well as coordinated assistance
