Stakeholders: Communities affected by conflict, natural disaster and/or development issues; Humanitarian Partners; Development Partners; Government; Private Sector (media, telecoms)

Guiding Questions: How will the CEWG benefit Afghans? How to add value at a local level? How to manage expectations? How to engage humanitarian and development partners, civil society, Government and media? How does the CEWG enhance AAP at an agency and a collective level?

Strategy: Target three elements: i. Use preferred approaches and mechanisms for information provision to communities and information received from communities; ii. Participation of communities (consultation and building on/using local capacities); iii. Establishment and maintenance of effective, functioning, accessible complaints, feedback and response mechanisms.
