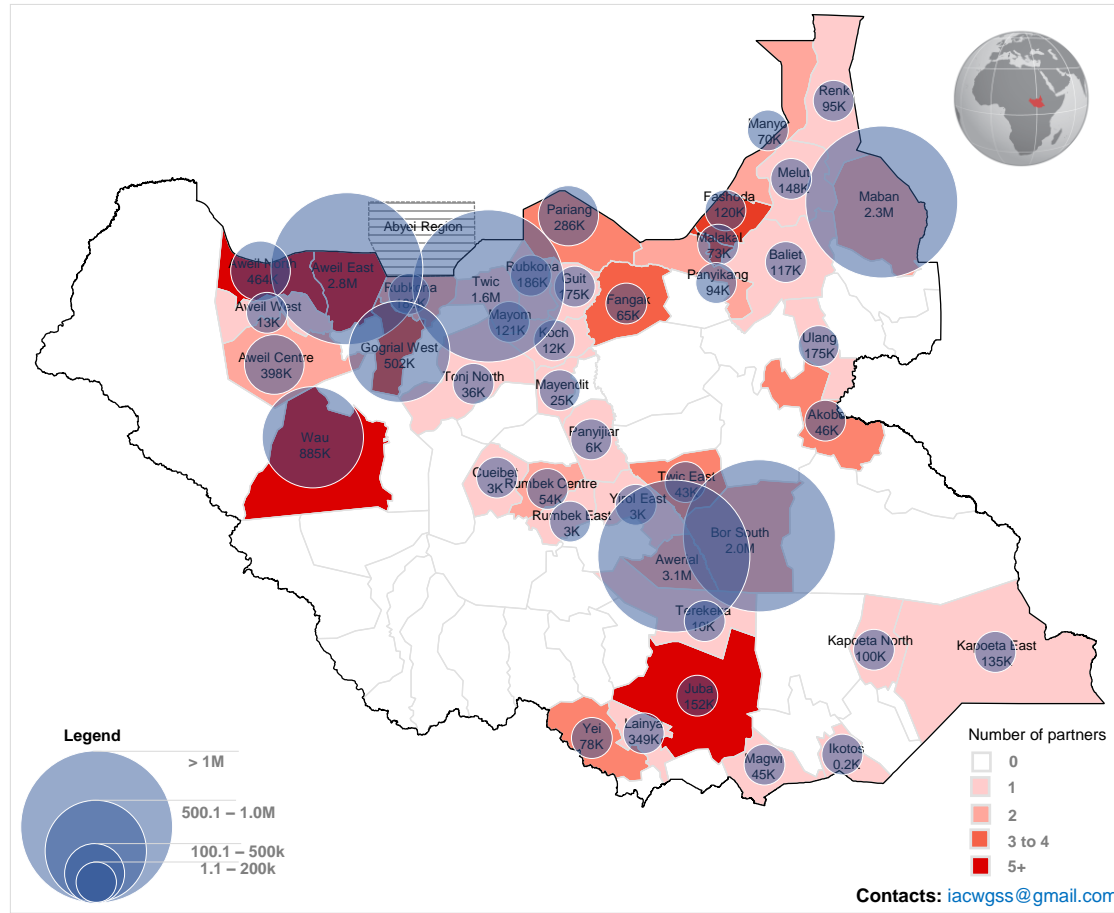
Quarterly Dashboard- Forth Quarter 2019

In the forth quarter (Oct to December) of 2019, Inter Agency Cash Working Group (IA – CWG) partners reported the transfer of US\$ 16.9million of Cash and Voucher Assistance (CVA) to 135,000 households (814,000 individuals) in South Sudan. The CVA was delivered through three main ways, cash (48%), voucher (34%) and service delivery (18%). Of the individuals receiving CVA, 59% were female, As the IA - CWG monitors all sectors, in this period, 99% of the total CVA value was channeled through the Food Security and Livelihood cluster.

To qualify for CVA, 83% of the affected population did not have to do anything. However, 52% of the assistance was restricted of the sort, meaning, the receivers have to use it for a specific purpose.

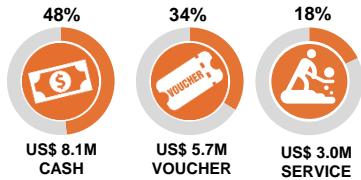

TOTAL CVA VALUE (Dollars)

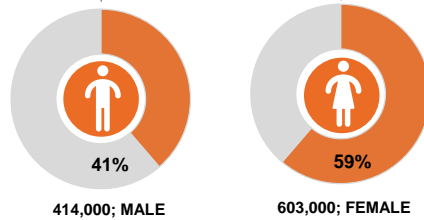

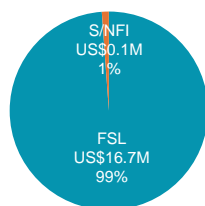
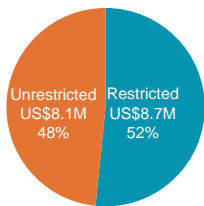
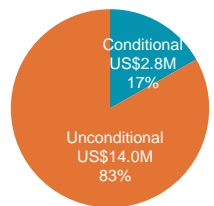
