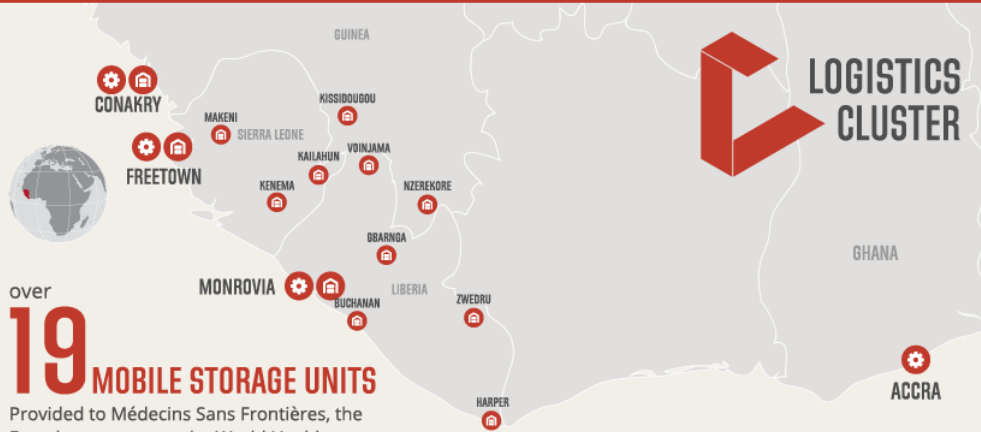

LOGISTICS CLUSTER OPERATIONS WILL CONSIST OF:

-  **Coordination:** Hubs in Accra, Conakry, Freetown and Monrovia, with coordination meetings held in all the above locations
-  **Storage:** Services in Guinea, Liberia and Sierra Leone with three main hubs and 11 Forward Logistics Bases (FLBs)
-  **Transport:** Based on needs, transport services can be provided from main hubs and FLBs to other strategic logistics locations
-  **Information Management:** Dedicated Information Management Officers in Conakry, Freetown and Monrovia and regional level in Accra
-  **Air coordination cell:** Daily update of flights to the affected countries and cargo space available. Facilitation of free access to a staging area in Europe to support partners planning and supply chain, co-loading and optimization of flights.
