Rage explained the three objectives: access to education & wellbeing, Safe reopening and control and prevention and key activities under each objective and the slight changes to the previous response plan. Under the new plan, if schools remain closed longer, the MoE will roll out distance learning for all primary children and start content development for secondary schools. For the safe reopening of schools, the plan ensures schools are safe for learning before it is opened.	Share the draft revised response plan with the partners.
