

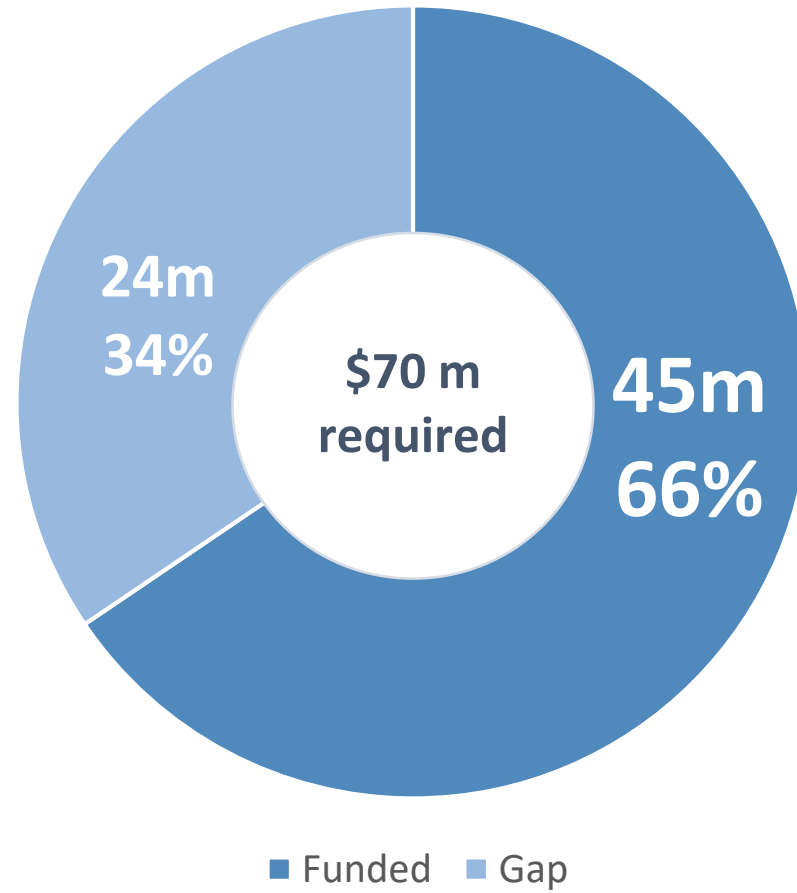

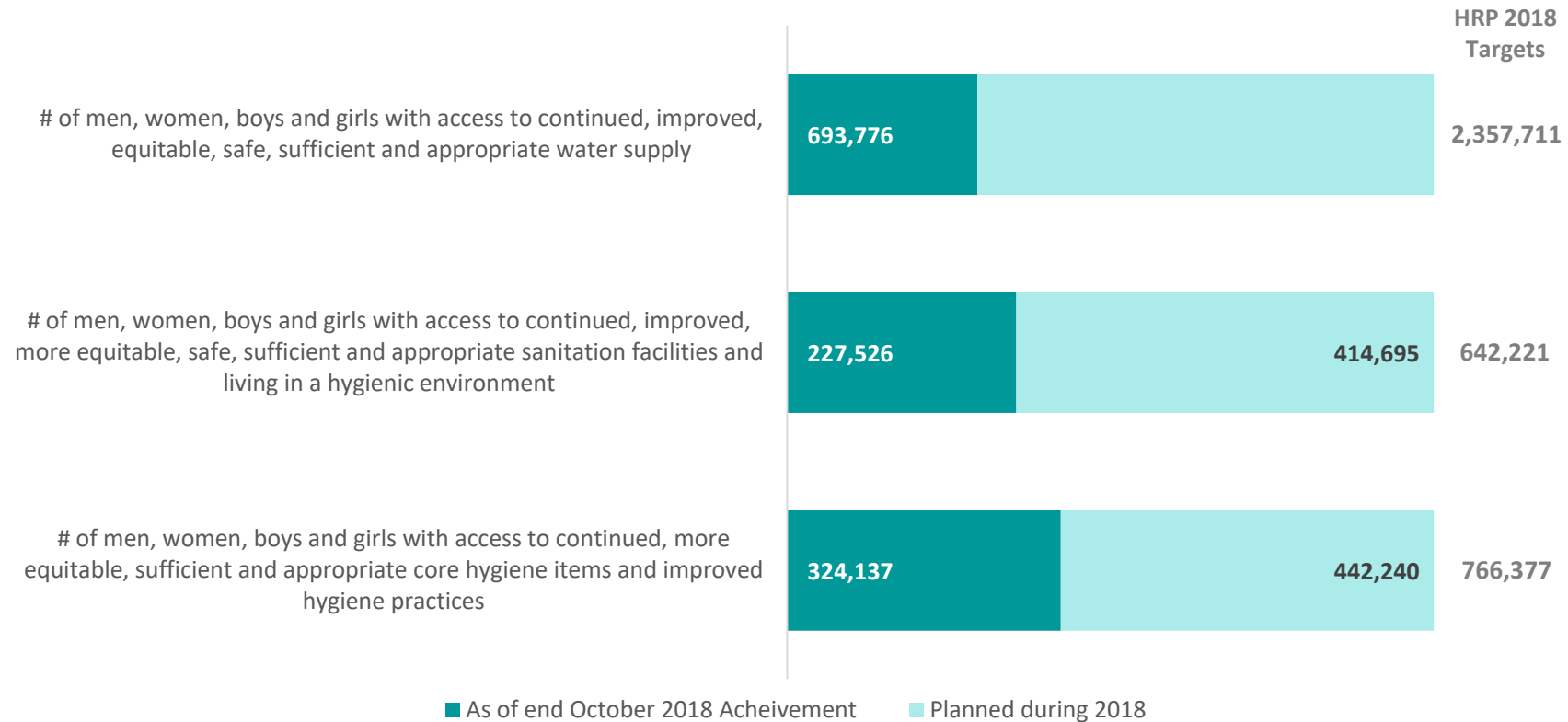

Overview of 2018 WASH Strategy

Objective 1: Operate, sustain and improve water and sanitation services and promote good hygiene practices



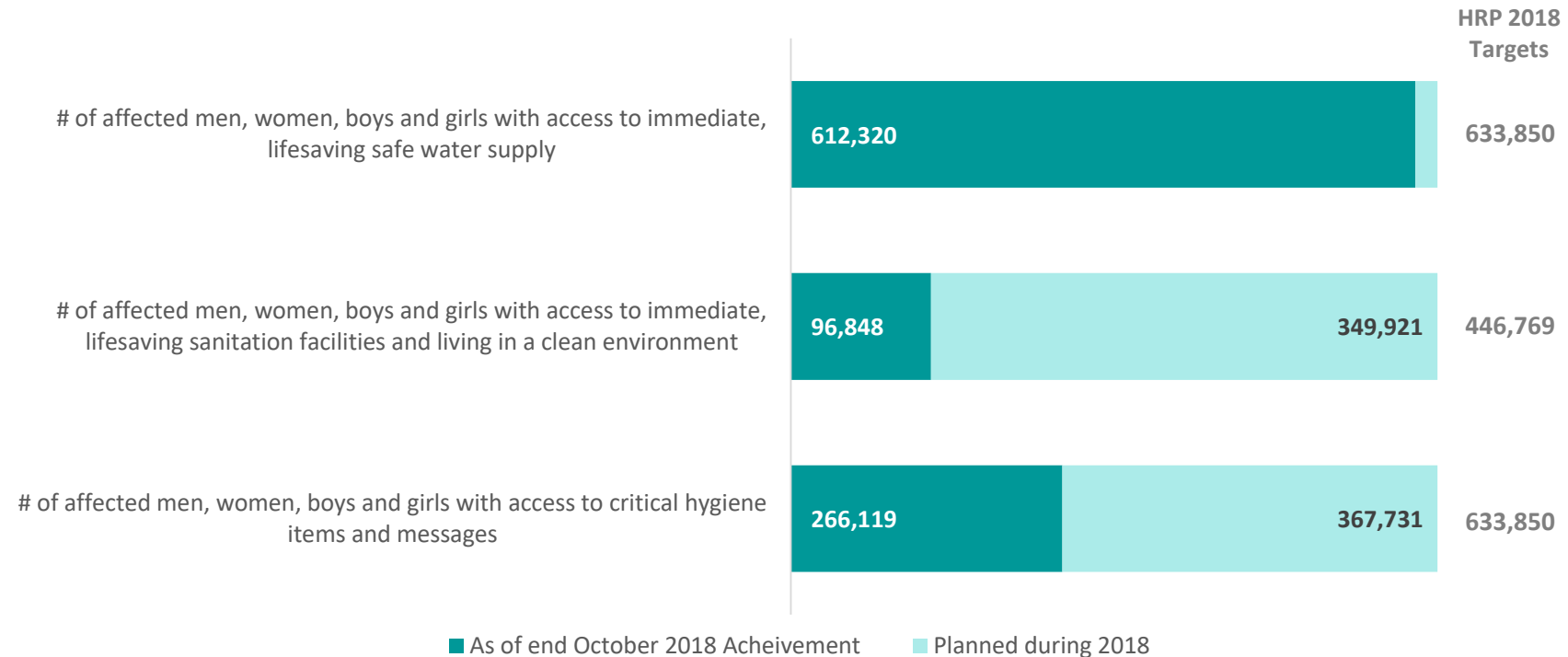
Activities:

Water: Pre-positioning core relief items and emergency equipment in priority locations; Identifying and developing water sources in emergency sites; Identifying and pre-qualifying emergency service providers; Installing emergency water tanks and taps in priority locations

Sanitation: Install emergency latrines, bathing facilities and solid waste collection points; Distribute of garbage collection items; Distribute waste bins

Hygiene: Basic hygiene awareness; Distribute critical hygiene items (soap and female hygiene items)

Objective 2: Provide emergency water and sanitation services and promote good hygiene practices



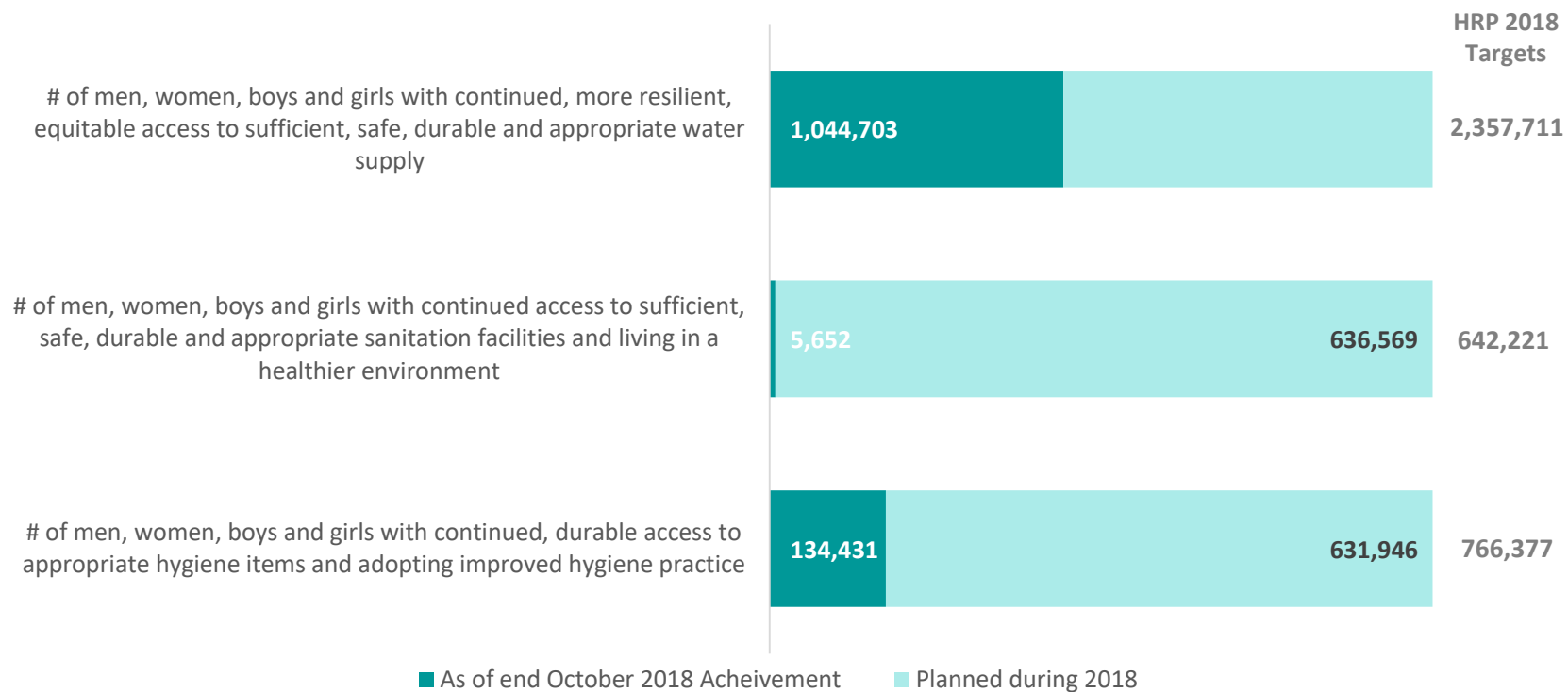
Activities:

Water: Transitioning from water trucking to durable modalities including boreholes, networks, and water treatment units; Strengthening WASH committees and the capacity of local WASH authorities; Introducing cost effective technologies including solar pumps and heaters

Sanitation: Install, rehabilitate sanitation & bathing facilities; recruit solid waste collectors, facilitate; Upgrading solid waste management systems; Ensure safe final treatment & disposal of waste; Decommissioning emergency facilities for re-use elsewhere and replacing units with durable options; Continued O&M of services

Hygiene: Distribute family hygiene kits/vouchers; Train hygiene promoters and community mobilizers; Expanding market-based approaches to hygiene

Objective 3: Provide sustainable/durable water and sanitation services and community focused good hygiene services



Activities:

Water: Expanding services to people with acute vulnerabilities including people living with disabilities; Restoring and extending water systems, connecting users to existing facilities and public networks including conventional systems in urban areas; Strengthening community management of services, capturing lessons learned, and agreeing on a timeline and plan for the orderly transfer of operations and maintenance to local institutions

Sanitation: Restore, extend sanitation systems, wastewater treatment; Install standardized sanitation, waste collection and disposal facilities, integrated with municipal services; promote safe final treatment and disposal of solid, liquid waste; Continued O&M of services

Hygiene: Promoting better hygiene practices and water conservation; Promote behaviour change; Recruit and train community mobilizers; Develop information, education and communication materials, activities
