Item	Summary of Discussion	Action Point(s)
1. Welcome and Introduction	Flora Macula, (HoSo UN Women/Co-chair of GiHA WG) chaired the meeting. She spoke about the achievements of the 16 days of Activism Against Gender-Based Violence so far according to GIHA plan and gave a presentation with some photos from the events. She informed the group that the same PP was presented to ISCG, HoSOs, and SMT meeting with CiCs. The focus was on issues raised by Rohingya women to CiCs on 25 th ,	Flora share the presentation with members. Collect the information from all meetings of Rohingya women with CiCs. Collect the number of social media views and followers. Prepare the joint report on 16 days of activism
2. Review of Previous Action Points	The action points of the 16 days of were reviewed. All previous action points noted in the last meeting held on the 20 th of November were discussed thoroughly and taken forward. Another meeting was held on the 24 th of November for distributing T-Shirt.	To continue with advocacy around GBV even after the 16 days of activism
3. Art Competition and Exhibition 10 th of December	Relief International at Camp -3 WGIFS, 17 QQWGIFS. Picnic by RTMI-Camp-4 ActionAid at Ocean Paradise 9 th and 10 th December(although this exhibition is not showing work done by Rohingya women, it is on GBV too)	Members to attend the exhibitions and share the pictures with the GiHA

4. Photo and Art Exhibition on the 8 th of March 2019	GiHA is going to arrange an exhibition on Women's Day with the photos from the activities of the 16 Days of Activism Against Gender-based Violence, 2018. The exhibition will also include some of the paintings made by the adolescent Rohingya girls who took part in the Art Competitions during the activism and shall be in spaces which can be accessed by both men and women. There is need to work with Adolescent girls and prepare them to express themselves through art.	Partners should seek consent from the girls concerning the exhibition. Each organization to work with adolescent girls and prepare them for the art competition for 8 of March, 2019
5. Orange Day	GiHA members will observe 'Orange Day' on the 25 th of every month. The idea is that members organize an event or activity on women empowerment and GBV prevention every 25 th of each month one organization to continue with the momentum of the 16 days.	Members to discuss with their teams and share their activities in the next meeting for planning purposes.
6. GBV Prevalence data	Some CiCs have asked for data on the prevalence of GBV in the refugee camps to give them a rough idea of the magnitude of the issue. A discussion was conducted around this and in line with the Do No Harm principle it was agreed that the estimates as reflected in the JRP shall be shared.	To collect the data available in the public domain to be presented to the CiCs.
7. CiCs	GiHA to organize a meeting with male authorities in the refugee camps especially the CiCs. We shall share with them our observations from the 16 days of activism and devise a clear strategy on how to work together and how the GiHA can support their work with women. Suggestions were made that we could plan the first meeting on 25 th of January as a start of the continuous Orange day observations.	To plan this meeting in January.

The next meeting will be held on the 17th of December, Monday at the UNHCR Conference Room. It will be a planning meeting where members shall agree on 2019 work plan - what activities and processes the GiHA should be part of.
