	Other legal assistance, representation and counselling	# of refugees provided with legal advice and counselling including victims of trafficking and exploitation, by age and sex	Record the number of girls, boys, women and men, including victims of trafficking and exploitation who have received legal advice and counselling

This includes refugee watch groups, community volunteers, boys and girls engaged in peer counselling, etc.
Persons with specific needs	Assistance to persons with specific needs through services incl. Case Management, follow up	# of refugees at heightened risk as well as victims of trafficking and exploitation, identified and supported, including through case management, by age and sex	Record number of girls, boys, women and men at heightened risk, as well as victims of trafficking and exploitation, identified and supported through case management
Life skills	Life Skills and resilience programming (including adolescent girls and boys)	# of individuals, including percentage of adolescents, benefiting from life skills and resilience programming, by age and sex	Record the number of girls, boys, women and men benefiting from life skills and resilience programming
