Welcome note and introduction of participants

Members were welcomed by the chair Shimoy from WARDI after a word of prayer by one of the participants. The members introduced themselves and their respective organizations.

Agenda	Updates of AWD in the region
	<p>Mercy- USA:- 14 AWD cases treated in Mahaas health center for Mercy USA. Five (5) of them were severe dehydrated and half of the total patients were below the age of five. Remarkably most of them came from a village called Bilcile which is near Mahas town.</p> <p>CESVI update AWD from Beledwayne hospital and halwadag MCH from 1st May upto 25th May seen 32 cases of AWD 12 under five 20 over five and also Farlibah MCH 87 cases AWD 36 under five 51 over five</p> <p>Hiddig:- seen in their two MCHs 18 cases of AWD and 7 of them were under five mostly were treated properly.</p> <p>WARDI:- Gerijir MCH supported by WARDI reported 85(37 over fives and 48 under fives) AWD cases in Gerijir and its vicinity in the last 2 weeks. Most of the cases are from villages bordering Ethiopia as well as pastoralists displaced from Mudug due to droughts. WARDI responded by delivering IV fluids and drugs with support of the MOH and cases treated. So far, 1 death of under five was reported at the facility though the community reported deaths which couldn't be verified. community health and hygiene promotion has also been intensified to prevent the spread of the AWD as most of the water sources (water pans and berkads are unprotected). WARDI requested more supplies from partners if possible especially IV fluids.</p>
Agenda	Updates of Measles in the region
	<p>Mercy- USA:- 2 Measles cases have been managed in Mercy USA Mahaas health centre. The two patients were male, un-immunized under five children who came from nomadic areas around Mahas</p>

town.

CESVI :- seen 1st upto 25th May from two MCH and hospital 45 cases 31 under five and are 14 over five, two of them were developed blindness due to measles complication

RI:- RI only runs smoothly the previous health centers and the cases of measles decrease in this week

Hiddig:- seen period of 25 days 26 cases of measles and treated properly

WARDI:- 26 cases mostly adults seen in Gerijir, Mataban district. Main cases come from Ethiopia and pastoralists from mudug and were treated at the facility.

Agenda Malaria training for Hiran partner staffs

WARDI implements malaria project funded by global fund. Part of the objectives is to capacity build staffs to be able to provide malaria diagnosis and treatment at community and facility level. In line with this, WARDI organized the trainings shown below with the support and approval of UNICEF and the MOH-National Malaria Control Program(NMCP). Some of the facilitators were from the NMCP/MOH.

Medium Malaria package case management training for MHC staffs in Hiraan region.	33 Nurses/midwives from 21 health centres across Hiraan region supported by 10 different NGOs. The NGOs and the number of staff per NGO are as follows:- WARDI 11, RI 6,CESVI 4, HICDO 2,Mercy-USA 2,Zamzam 2,Sanabil 1, Direct aid 1, Hiddig 2 and SRCs 2.	22 nd May to 27 th May 2017

As part of the global fund malaria prevention strategy, WARDI distributed 54,000 LLINs to 103,286(12,881HHs) drought and displacement affected persons in Mataban district in the last 3weeks.

Reccomendation

Members recommended to conduct measles acceleration campaign to Beletweyne and Mataban districts of Hiran region, as the majority of the cases were reported from those areas, in order to increase the immunization coverage and prevent mass measles out break.
