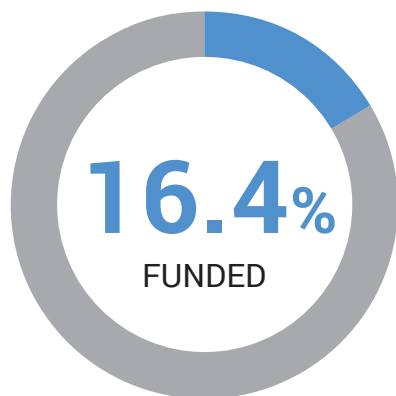


# 2019 Syria Humanitarian Response Plan (HRP) FUNDING OVERVIEW

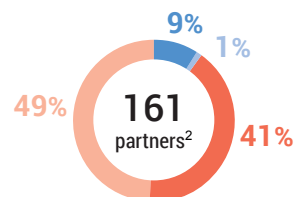

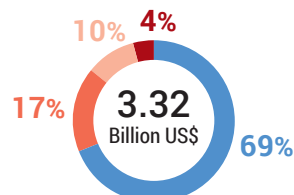

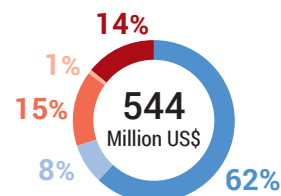

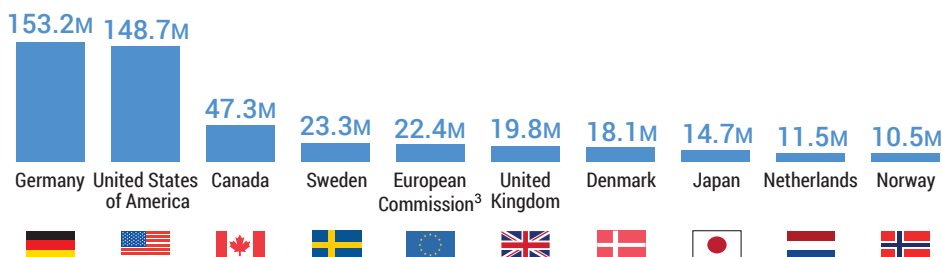
