

November 2020 updates


In November 2020, the humanitarian community tracked some 44,000 IDP movements across Syria, similar to movement numbers tracked in September. As in recent months, most IDP movements were concentrated in northwest Syria, with 89 percent occurring within and between Aleppo and Idlib governorates.

At the sub-district level, Dana sub-district in Idlib governorate received the largest number of IDP movements – around 5,000 movements – followed by Bulbul sub-district in Aleppo governorate with some 4,500 IDP movements. A'zaz and Atareb sub-districts in Aleppo governorate and Maaret Tamsrin, Ariha, Idlib and Salqin sub-districts in Idlib governorate each received some 2,000 IDP movements, and more than 1,000 IDP arrivals were recorded in Daret Azza sub-district in Aleppo governorate.

At the community level, A'zaz and Bulbul communities in Aleppo governorate received the largest number of displaced people, with around 1,000 movements each in November. Some 800 IDP movements each were received by Deir Hassan-Darhashan and Idlib communities in Idlib governorate and Qorna and Aleppo city in Aleppo governorate, while As-Sweida community in As-Sweida governorate and Shamarin community in Aleppo governorate each received some 700 IDP movements this month.

These movements are estimated to mostly be incentivised by access to services and livelihoods, and facilitated by reduced levels of shelling compared to previous months.
