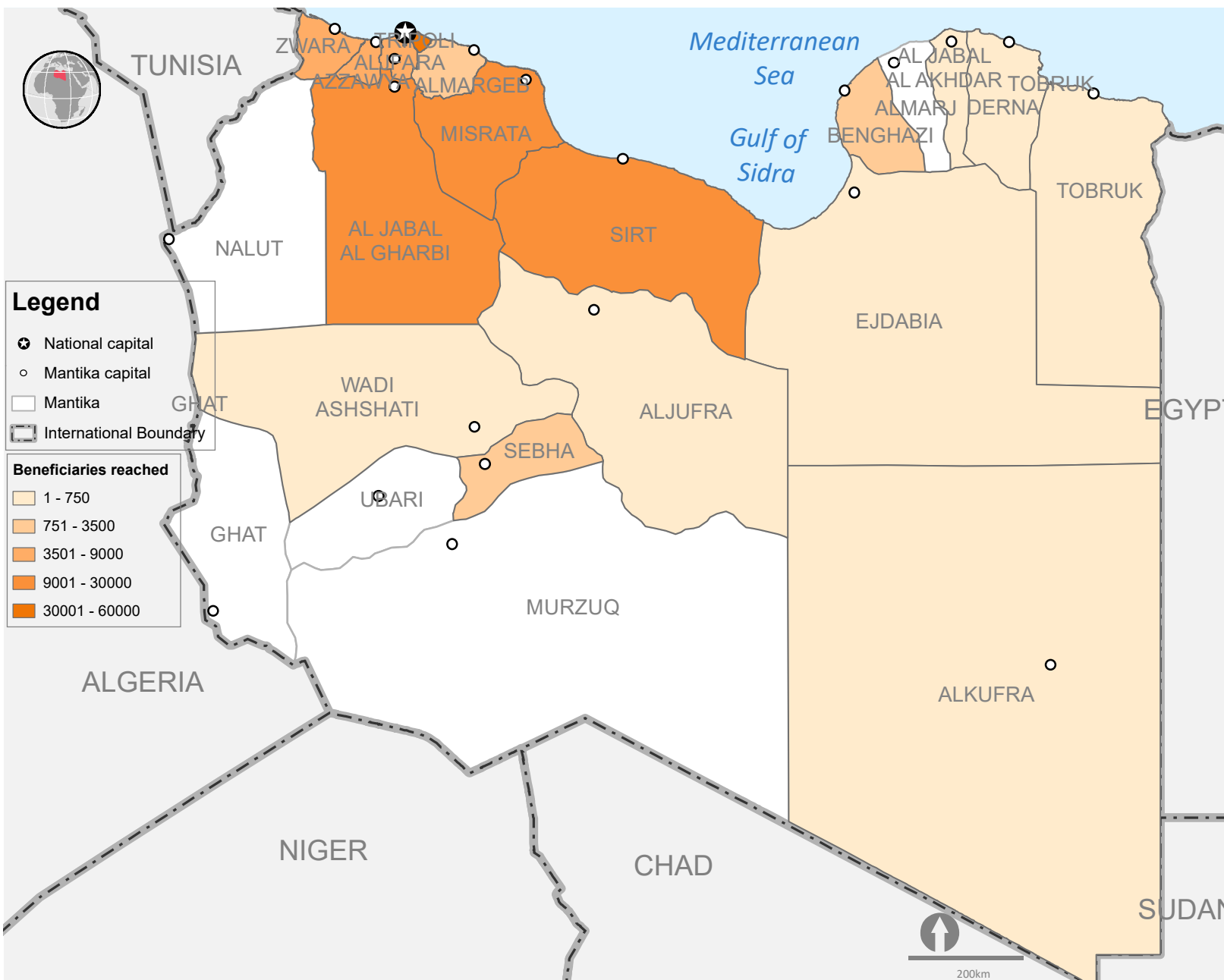


# LIBYA: Protection sector response snapshot as of June 2019

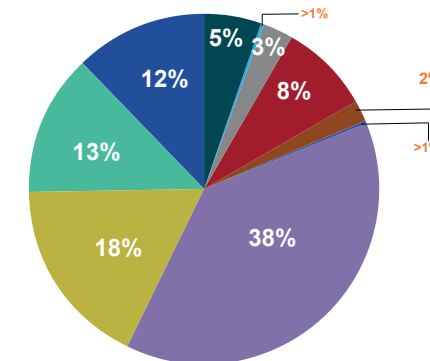

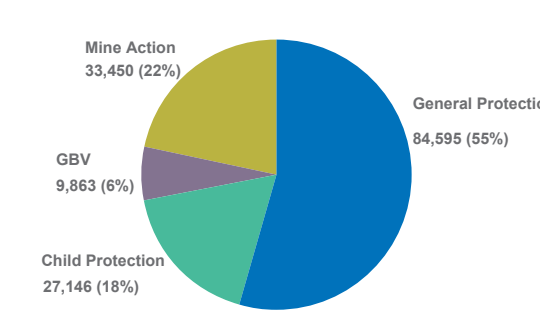

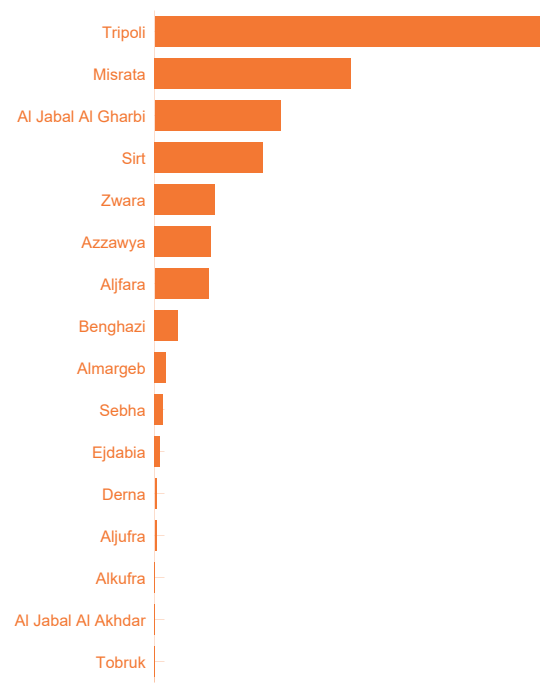
