Summary:

The presentation explains the Education in Emergency Needs at Amanat Al Asimah which includes:

- Support Children Support Centers (100 centers) on Supportive Education and Psychological support during summer holiday for the Academic year 2020.

- Training of 10,000 teachers in 100 school in Active Education.
- Training of 2,000 teachers in life skills in 25 schools.
- Training of 6,000 teachers in Psycho-social support in Emergency.
- Training of 9,000 teachers in alternative methods of punishment in 100 schools.
- Forming health clubs in 150 schools.
- Training of 150 of Education and Administration leadership on Educational planning and supervision.
- Training of 90 of Education and Administration leadership on Education in Emergency.
- Capacity building for School administration including Headmasters, deputies and Inspectors (1,000) on School Administration guideline (part1 and 2).
- Capacity building for 700 inspectors in Active Education.
- Capacity building for 400 inspectors in supervision guidelines (parts1,2 and 3).
- Capacity building for 5,000 teachers and administrative staff in improving education environment and safety measures in Emergency.
- Forming and training of mothers and fathers councils for 270 schools and activating community participation.
- Hygiene promotion for 555 teachers in 185 schools (3 in each school).
- Contracting 3,000 teachers to fill the gap.
- Life skills programs in 60 schools.
- Teachers and inspectors incentives in Amanat Al Asimah.
- National Test support.
- School textbooks (545,000,0) textbooks.
- Providing 150,000 students bags.
- Providing 150,000 school uniform.
- Providing 300 recreational kits for 75 schools.
- Providing 300 Educational kits for 75 schools.
- Providing 300 sports kits for 75 schools.
- Finishing 75 projects of schools building.
- Building 80 emergency stairs for the schools of single stairs.
- Rehabilitation of 337 schools.
- Building one totally damaged school.
- Building two partially damaged school.
- Rehabilitating 50 schools.
- Building latrines for 50 schools.
- Wash rehabilitation for 150 schools.
- Building 300 TLSs.
- Providing 18,000 double seats.
- Providing 1,000 single seats.
- Providing the tools, equipment and labor wages to repair 25,000 seats.
- Building 150 washing hand basin in schools.
- Building 150 water tanks for 100 schools.
- Provide solar system for 100 schools.

- Plantation for 100 schools.
- Provide cleaning materials and stationary for 337 schools.
- Provide 337 first Aid boxes for schools.
- Provide 674 fire extinguishers.
- Supply 116 schools with clean water.
- Provide 337 operational bonus for schools.
- Provide 500 class boards big size.
- Equipping 15 kindergartens.
- Providing 100 nannies for nurseries in 100 schools.
- Providing solar system to Education Office in Sana'a.
- Completing construction work for 40 schools.
- Building 10 schools 12 classes in each school.
- Provide school broadcasting tools and school bells for 100 school.
- Hygiene promotion for 120 schools.
- Mine dangers promotion in 150 schools.
