Introductions and Action points from last meeting	
<p>EYN reported the situation in Chibok where there is fear among adolescent girls to go back to school due to the security situation, in addition to increasing poverty among parents. Adolescent girls are exposed to exploitation. EYN and Plan International had a meeting on the issue of Chibok Adolescent girls fear to go back to school.</p> <p>Oslo Conference on Ending Sexual and GBV Oslo, 23–24 May 2019. NCA Updated on the consultations done with different stakeholders and the process for registration and participation in the conference.</p> <p>Call for participation in Training for Human Rights Defenders in Northeast Nigeria was sent out. Plan International distributed 74 dignity kits. Food and Shelter gaps. INTERSOS and NCA to provide support to fill gaps. GBV messaging and IEC Task force, led by INTEROS have finalised the key messages. These are currently awaiting translation by Translators Without Borders (TWB). When finalised, these will be shared with partners.	
GBV Case Management Update	
<p>The GBV SS with support from UNFPA is supporting GBV Case management trainings in Borno, Yobe and Adamawa. These trainings are part of the roll out for the GBV Case Management capacity building plan. A Call for applications for the training was shared and partners who have GBV case management programming are invited to apply.</p> <p>The GBV Case Management technical working group have developed Standard Operating Procedures (SOP), CM guidelines and tools. The next steps include rolling out of the guidelines and tools to be adapted. Some key challenges include limited time to develop guidelines and tools; and low participation in attending meetings.</p>

Provision of ID cards, administration of death certificates, group counselling, prison visitations pro bono services. 2 perpetrators charged and 6 pending cases of GBV.
