<u>Partners updates</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ammar is the new National Co-Coordinator, taking over from Waleed since December 2018. - DOW will relocate to a new building at the following GPS location: 36° 20'02.3"N 43° 08'26.7"E. - <u>WATER SUPPLY:</u> - Tearfund has allocated budget for 3 months to implement a project to supply water in Salamiyah 2 (elevated tanks and boosters), but there is no confirmation from their partners in this project (UNHCR and QRC) to carry on with the project. - Acted: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Assessment for water infrastructure. ▪ 2 projects for rehabilitation of water infrastructure in 6 sites. ▪ Problem of duplication in Abo Maria water station ▪ Small infrastructure rehabilitation activities targeting schools and hospitals. - DRC: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Looking to assess potential projects or partnerships in Ninewa (water treatment plants and water networks) ▪ Currently starting assessment phase for February. 	<p>DoW to update their main priorities and share it with partners.</p> <p>Partners to contact Tearfund on this email: NIJEN.AHMED@TEARFUND.ORG for possible projects suggestions or needs to provide options to reallocate their budget</p> <p>SI to arrange a meeting with one of UN's agencies (UNDP in particular) to coordinate information sharing systematically between partners to avoid any duplication in projects</p> <p>Acted to update the 4W for the activities mentioned.</p> <p>Partners interested in working in Ninewa to coordinate with DRC for any possible opportunities.</p>

Project is in contracting phase now, and to start in March. ▪ Upon mid-term holiday for schools, Hygiene Kits to be distrusted for schools in Mosul, hamdaniya and Telkif. ▪ In telafar, rehabilitation of pipe line connecting Abo Maria station to Ayadia has been completed. - RNVDO: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Currently working on water trucking in Jada'a camps to provide 1000 m³/day through UNCIF partners in the camp. ▪ In finishing stages for a project with NCA to provide 300 m³/day of water in 4 villages in Muhalabiya. ▪ Currently, in the process of upgrading WASH facilities in the camps. - Islamic Relief: WNR in shefa'a neighborhood for 9600 m has been completed. - Help: managed to complete WNR rehabilitation completed in Hamdaniya, Bazwaya, Bartala. In addition, Completed Rehabilitation of Bartala water pumping station. There are new allocated budget for 23 new project. - IIRP: Currently rehabilitating 5 WTP different parts of Nineveh governorate. - SI: Will start complete WASH service in Nimrud camp 2, and in assessment phase to start WASH project in Muhalabia. - Save the children to start rehabilitation of 3 WTP in Hadar, and 2 WNR projects will be completed in Shifa'a and Bablikish in the old city. - SANITATION: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Tearfund: currently negotiating with UNICEF to rehabilitate 70-80 latrine in Jada'a camp, because other partners are planning to implement the similar project in the same camp. - DRC: planning to start SWM (Collection campaign, Hygiene promotion, and garbage container distribution) in Khadra, Adan and Samah. - Save the children: distributed 16m³ trash containers in West Mosul in 	<p>Other partners to suggest other possible sanitation projects for tearfund to implement in Nineveh.</p> <p>Partners to share more sustainable solutions for SWM projects.</p>

In addition, will start rehabilitation of 750 latrine and shower (on household level) and distribution of 8 trash containers of 16m³ capacity in the old city.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Islamic relief: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Rehabilitation of 5 pump stations for DoS in Mosul and sewage networks in Telafar. ▪ On going CFW cleaning campaign for sewage in neighborhoods inside Mosul. ▪ Just started Implementing new drainage channel in Jada'a 6 camp to prepare for possible floods. - FRC: Currently working on SWM in West Mosul, that includes Solid waste collection, and in January, 2500 of trash bins with capacity of 100 L were distributed, in addition, 1766 trash bins with capacity of 120 L were distributed in Zanjili in west Mosul, however, there is still a gap of 1000 Household in the same area. Also working on desludging campaign in 6 neighborhoods. - HYGIENE : - Tearfund: Planning to start hygiene promotion in salamyia camp 2 in coordination with UNICEF and Pekawa. - OTHER : - Save the children to start MSNA in 2 weeks in Nineveh governorate. 	<p>Ninewa Cluster to approach UNDP to share a list of municipalities that received garbage collection trucks.</p> <p>FRC to shared the names of the neighborhoods for the desludging campaign.</p>
