

## THE PROTECTION SECTOR VIRTUAL LEARNING SESSIONS APRIL – JUNE 2020

The Protection Sector Virtual Learning Sessions were borne out of the need to continue to build the capacity of partners to identify and respond to protection issues even during the COVID-19 restriction measures.

Targeted at protection staff working in field locations, the sessions held twice weekly from April to June, and covered 17 topics, ranging from Protection Principles, Protection Mainstreaming and Legal Framework for the Protection of IDPs, to Basic Child Protection Concepts, Integrating GBV into Protection Programming and Psychological First Aid.

The sessions were facilitated by the four Sub-Sector Coordinators, UNHCR, IRC, NRC and others, using Microsoft Teams.

A total of 513 participants attended the 17 sessions.
