

Overview of 2019 Education Cluster Response

An estimated 2.8 million girls and boys between 3 and 18 years of age and 42,902 teaching personnel needed education. Education cluster targeted 786,324 children (3-18 years old; 42 % girls, 58 % boys); 16,500 teaching personnel, SMCs and PTAs in geographical areas affected by conflict, displacement or facing acute food insecurity levels. Focus was given to emergency affected areas with significant IDPs presence and where the gaps in the provision of education was greatest.

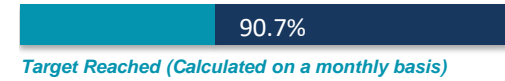
A total of 24 HRP partners comprised of 9 NGO, 14 INGO and 01 UN Agency were identified for the 2019 response and funding of 53.7 million was required for 2019 education response.

A total of 713,399 children and 15,250 adults were reached and trained respectively by both HRP and Non HRP partners. HRP partners provided service to 70.1 % of targeted children and 84.6% adults were trained. An achievement which is extra ordinary given the limited funding of 40.1 % received by education cluster.

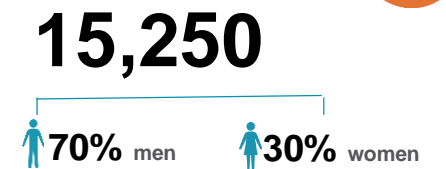

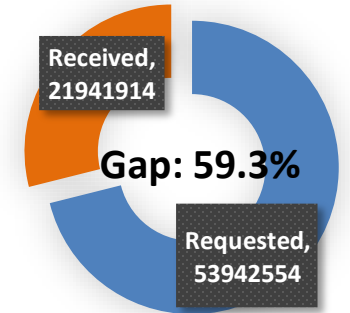

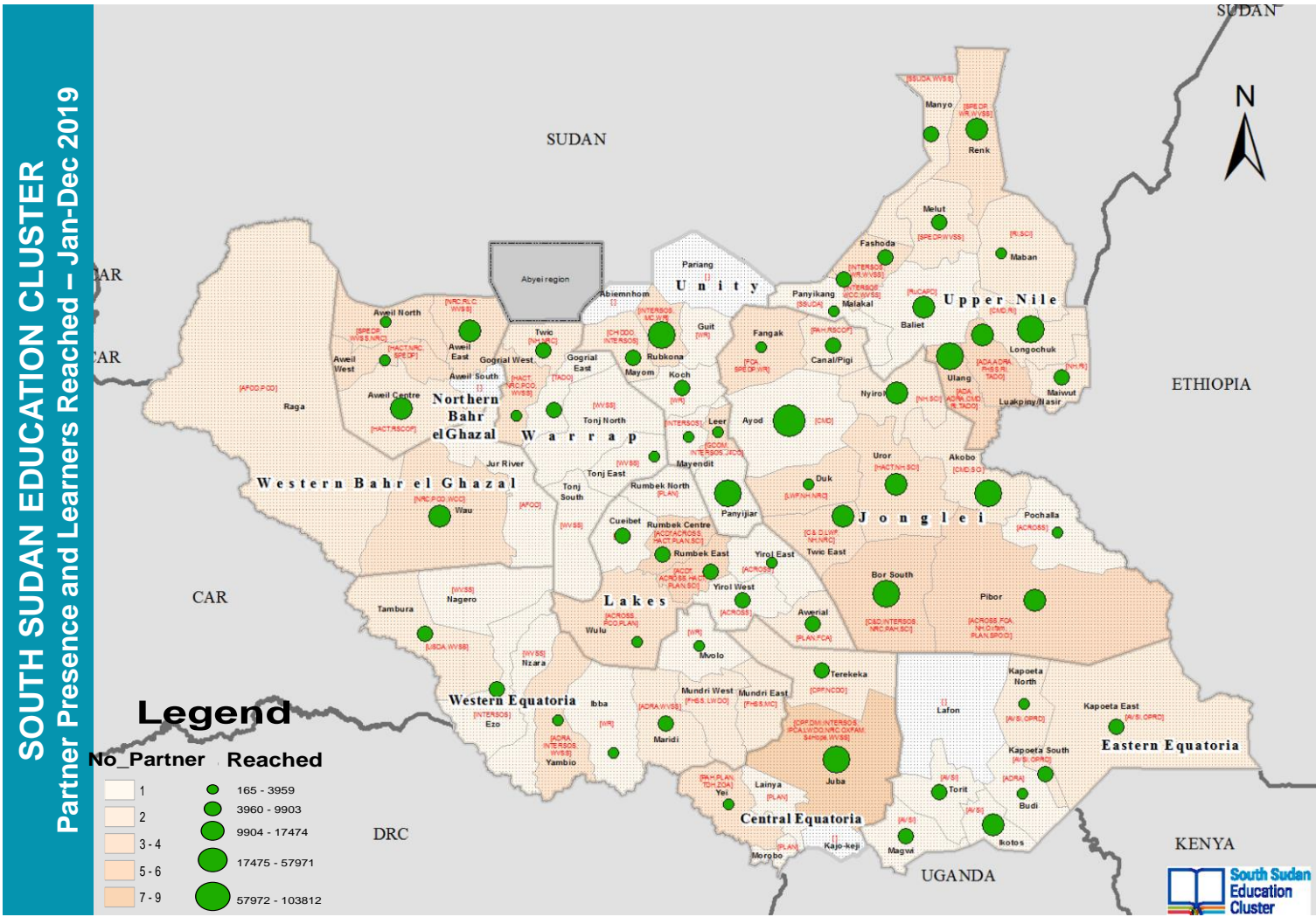
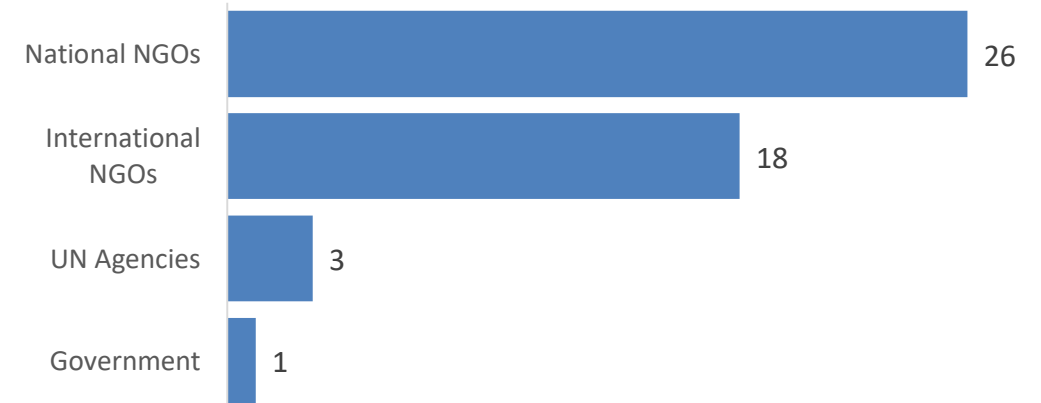

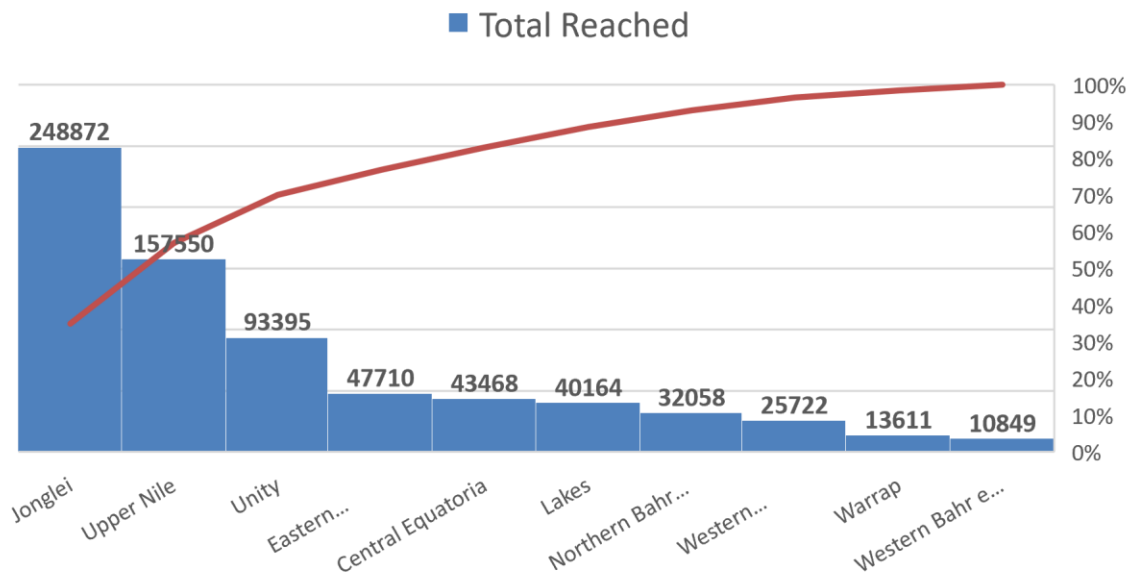

Partner Presence and Learners Reached – Jan-Dec 2019

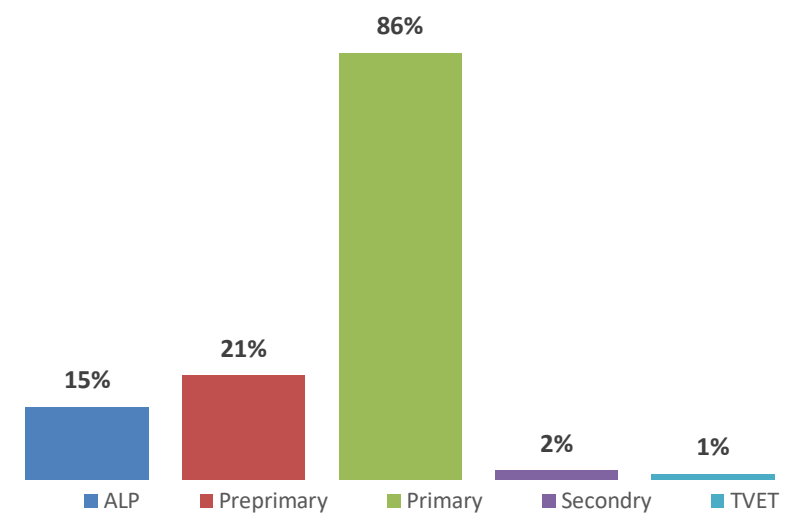


LEARNER-ENROLMENT

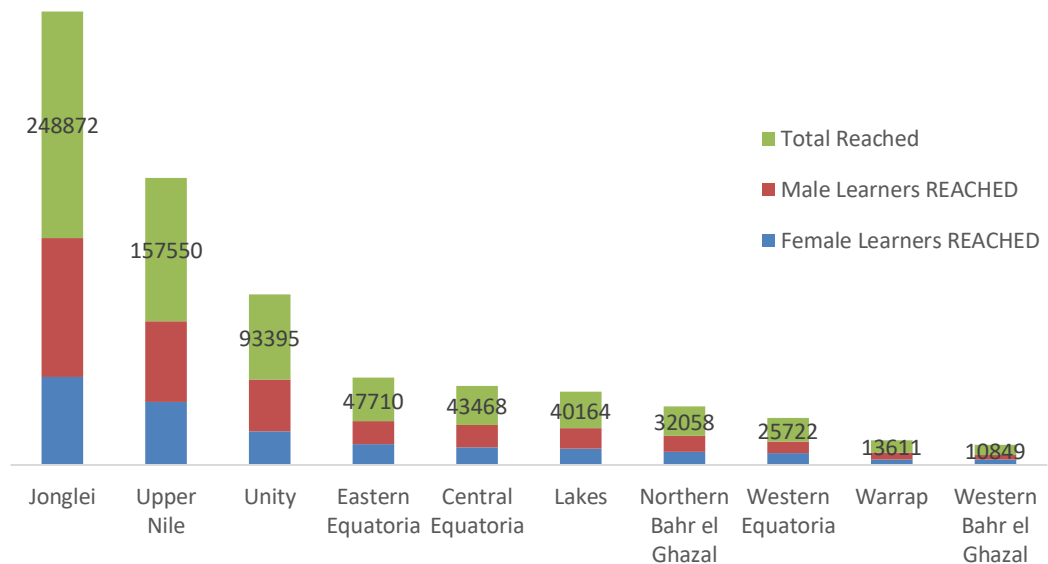


ENROLMENT - SCHOOL LEVEL

LEARNER ENROLMENT - GENDER Comparison

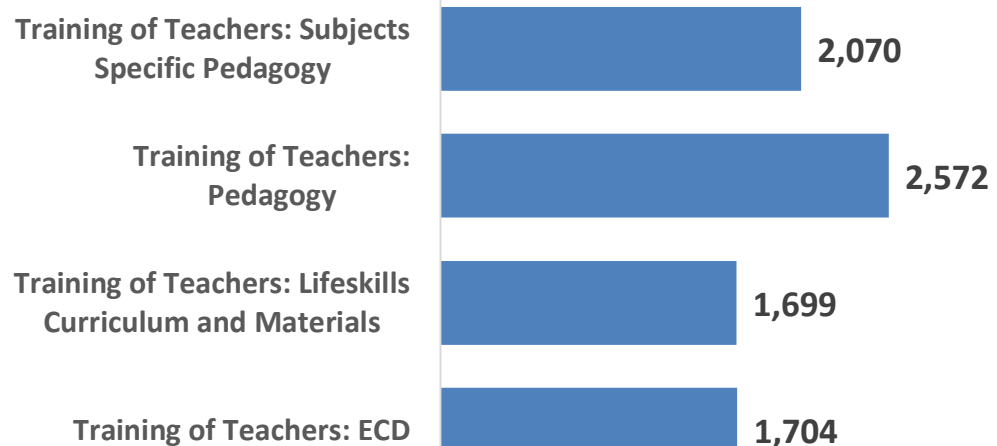

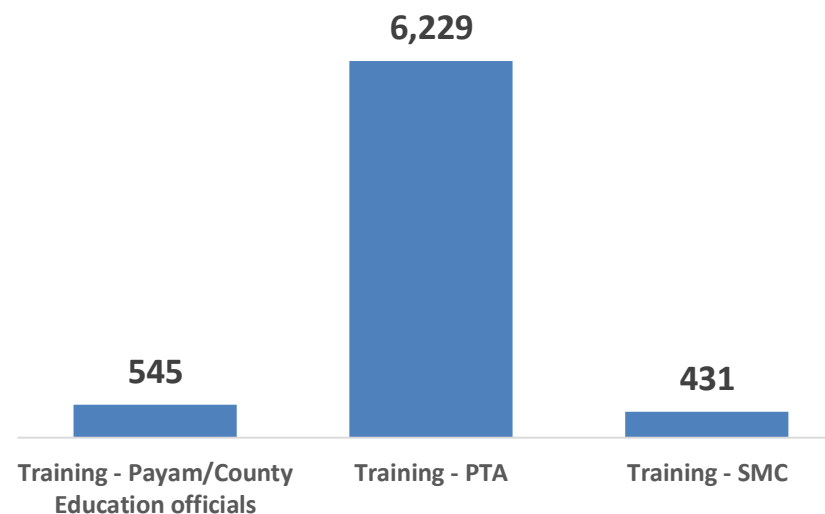

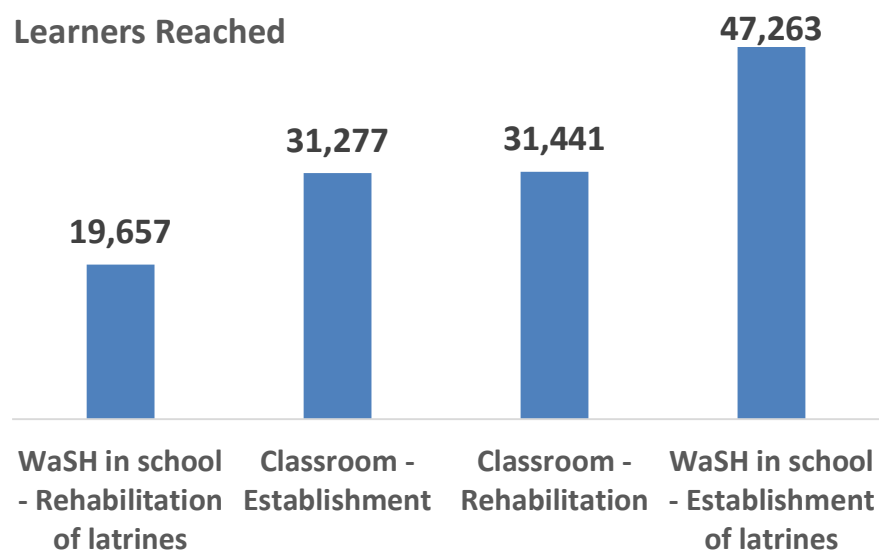
