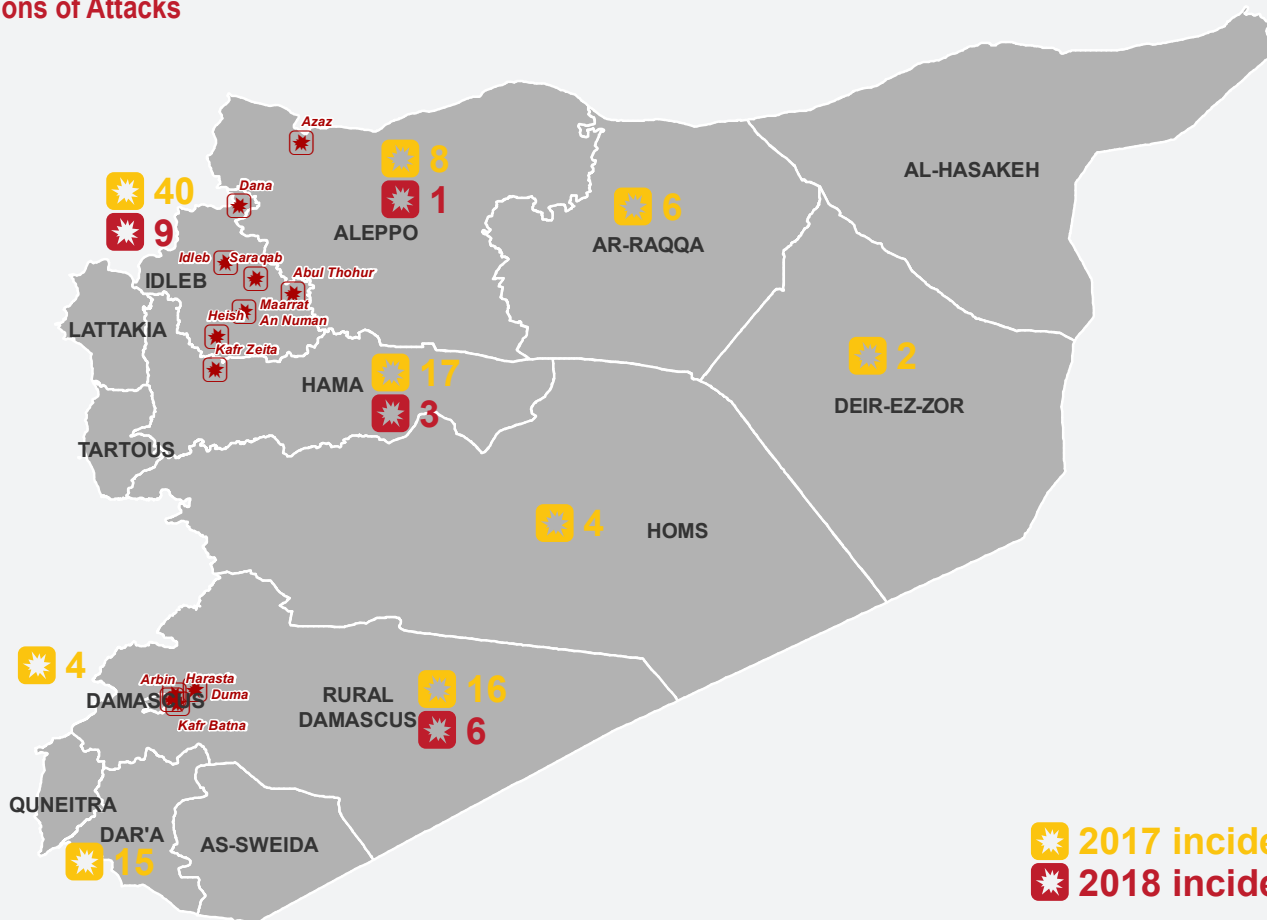


Turkey|Syria: Violence Against Health Care

Governorates Overview in 2018

Idleb
7 incidents were reported in Saraqib sub district, the only hospital in Saraqib were targeted 4 times as well as 2 PHCs and blood bank. Monthly, the hospital is providing an average of 5000 consultations, 320 surgeries. Initial report showed three medical staff were injured, two patients and one child were killed. The attack on blood bank resulted in structural damages. Ma'arrat An Nu'man hospital was also targeted 2 times. One PHC each was targeted in Tah, Abul Thohur, Idleb and Mardikh sub districts, in addition, to an ambulance in Dana.

Hama
Kafar Zita Hospital was attacked thrice; the facility remained partially open. Monthly, the hospital is providing an average of 1600 consultations, 140 admissions, 60 major surgeries and 50 war related trauma treatments.

Aleppo
Mental health hospital supported by national NGO in A'zaz sub district, Aleppo was impacted by a mortar shells resulted in huge structural damages. Initial report showed one patient killed and twelve were injured all of them are females.

Rural Damascus
6 incidents were reported in Rural Damascus (2 Kafr Batna, 2 in Harasta, 1 in Arbin and Duma sub districts). 3 PHCs were targeted and 3 health workers were killed.

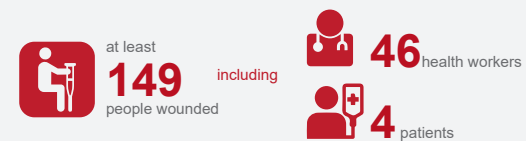
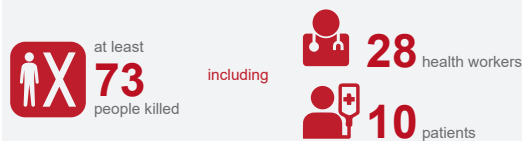
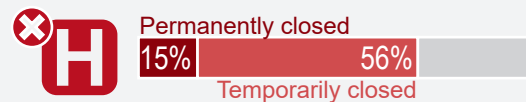
Reported Gas Attacks - February 2018

3 patients presented with difficulty in breathing. In Eastern Ghouta (Rural Damascus); **3** patients presented with difficulty in breathing. Saraqab (Idleb); **17** patients presented with difficulty in breathing.

Impact in 2017

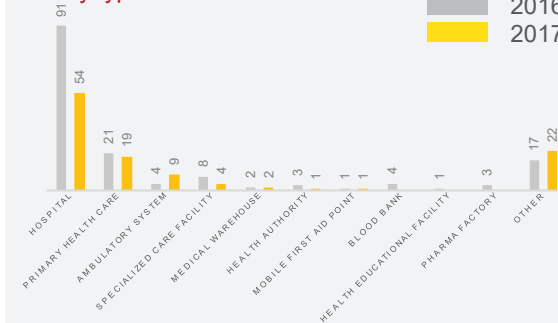


Hospitals were the most affected in 2017, followed by **primary health care centers** and ambulatory services.
