Topic 1: Updates on current situation in Libya	
Summary of discussion	<p><b>Statistics:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Currently 355,672 IDPs (70,793 families) as of Dec 2019. (Updates as of Round 28 IOM)</li> <li>- 149,315 IDPs since April 2019.</li> <li>- 447,706 ind (89,466 families) returnees recorded so far.</li> <li>- 636,426 migrants as of Round 27 IOM.</li> <li>- 101,073 migrants living in urban areas.</li> <li>- 4,475 migrants held in detention centres.</li> <li>- 1,945 migrants received core relief items including hygiene items in 6 detention centres,</li> <li>- 9,333 IDPs received NFIs in urban areas,</li> <li>- Since the previous DTM update on 31 January 2020, an additional 153 families (765 individuals) have been internally displaced due to the deteriorated security situation in the areas of Abu Qurayn and Sirt bringing the total to at least 558 families (2,790 individuals) displaced from their homes.</li> <li>- WASH Sector in coordination with RRM is responding through provision of NFIs.</li> </ul>
Topic 3: HRP Prioritization exercise and Covid 19	

Summary of discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No Covid-19 cases as of now in Libya,</li> <li>• A preparedness and response plan is in process under ISCG</li> <li>• ISCG decision not to completely revise HRP 2020 but to make a prioritisation out of existing HRP.</li> <li>• Thus far WASH sector identification of people to be prioritised 62,000 and budget requirement 3.7 M USD (for 8 months) and 1.7 M USD for three months (April, May and June).</li> <li>•</li> </ul>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Due to the current circumstances arise as a result of Covid 19 and subsequent suspension of meetings etc, WASH Sector has postponed Sector Strategic Planning workshop until further notice.</li> </ul>
