Summary of discussion	<p>Statistics:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No changes since last updates of Round 29 by IOM DTM: - Currently 373,709 IDPs as of Feb 2019. (Updates as of Round 29 IOM) - 96% displaced due to conflict, with to 3 regions of displacement being Tripoli, Misrata and Almagheb - 448,573 ind returnees recorded so far with top 3 regions for return Tripoli, Sirt and Benghazi. - For further details follow the link: https://displacement.iom.int/reports/libya-%E2%80%94-idp-and-returnee-key-findings-report-29-jan-feb-2020 - 653,800 migrants as of Round 29 IOM. - 11 % women and 7 % children. Topic 3: Covid 19 and WASH Sector response	
Summary of discussion	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A total of 6066 suspected cases of COVID 19 have been reported by NCDC/ MoH, out of them 182 cases have been confirmed COVID cases as of 2nd June.

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cases mostly in Tripoli, Surman, Misrata and Benghazi. New cases emerging mostly in Sabha. 10 cases tested positive in single day in Sabha. • UNICEF start leading on RCCE working group. WASH sector partners advised to coordinate with the group in order for contribution under this pillar. • WASH Sector aims to co-lead the IPC (Infection prevention and control) in the Covid-19 Libya response. • Partners advised to strengthen their responses in IPC and sector to enhance partner's capacity on IPC. • DRC reported distribution of 1,353 hygiene kits in Covid response in Tripoli, Gargarash and Anjela, having an additional capacity of 1,000 kits. • PUI working in detention centres in East and provided hygiene kits to 172 men and 5 women, supported by UNHCR.
