

Somalia: Humanitarian Snapshot (as of 7 June 2017)

The *Gu* rains started later than normal and have so far been below average in all areas, except in the northeast where rains have been near average, according to FAO-SWALIM. An elevated risk of famine persists in some parts of the country. Major disease outbreaks and drought driven displacement continue. Humanitarians are scaling up famine prevention activities, reaching millions of people with life-saving assistance.

DISEASE OUTBREAKS

AWD/cholera and measles are spreading. 15 out of 18 regions in Somalia have reported cases of AWD/cholera. More than 8,000 measles cases, half of them among children under age 5, have been reported.


Humanitarian partners are responding to contain the outbreaks.

Oral cholera and measles vaccination campaigns ongoing in drought-affected areas.

In Togdheer and Sanaag regions 10 water purification teams were commissioned.


In Puntland 59 mobile teams were deployed to IDP settlements and house to house mobilization was conducted.

Four Integrated Diarrhoeal Disease Kits were distributed. Over 500 carry blair tubes were also distributed for stool sample collection and laboratory diagnosis in Somaliland.



Humanitarian response

Humanitarian partners continue to scale-up response. Millions of people at risk of starvation and diseases were reached with life-saving assistance, livelihood support and protection services.

FUNDING

The revised HRP seeks **US\$1.5 billion** to reach 5.5 million people with life-saving assistance in 2017. Overall, donors have contributed **\$674 million** to scale up famine prevention in Somalia.
